ORZOVA, Servia, Sept. 28.—The kings of Servia and Roumania arrived here yes-torday to attend the ceremony of the opening of the Iron Gate canal, and were warmly greeted by Emperor Francis Jo-seph of Austria, who arrived on Saturday, accompanied by Count Goluchowski.
