MR. GOULD DISGUSTED.

The Yacht Niagara's Owner Dislikes British Methods.

WILL NOT RACE NEXT SEASON.

The Unwarranted Examination of His Vessel, Without Apology Therefor, Decides the American Yachtsman to Retire from International Contests.

tion, regarding a visit by a committee of three from that association made to Mr. Gould's yacht Niagara last May while at her moorings, without having sent Mr. Gould any notice of the intended visit, and on which occasion the committee made an examination of the yacht so as to ascertain whether there was any truth in the report that she was fitted with water tanks on each side of the cabin, which were connected by pipes, so as to obtain a shifting water ballast.

Mr. Gould says in his communication that the ynchting season has now ended, and before returning home to America he feels it his duty to send this communica-tion. He had hoped all summer, he says, to receive a letter from the Yacht Bacing

to receive a letter from the Yacht Racing association which would have made the communication unnecessary. After pointing out that the construction of the water tanks on the Niagara were visible to the eye and known to many members of the Yacht Racing association, and that Niagara had raced throughout 1855 unquestioned. Mr. Gould tells of the visit of the committee to his facht with-out notice during his absence, and his re-ceipt of a letter five days later from Dixon celpt of a letter five days later from Dixon Kemp, secretary of the association, noti-fying him of the committee's visit and de-

Mr. Gould's answer to Secretary Kamp's

Mr. Gould's answer to Secretary Emp's latter is in part as follows: "Any reports that the Niagara's tanks were used for shifting ballast are abso-lutely false, and I fall to see how they in any way conflict with the association rules. However, for the sake of harmony, I am willing to make any change that will meet the approval of the committee, providing the change does not increase the yacht's weight. Dixon Kemp's reply to this suggests the removal of the connection and a separate pipe service for each tank, which would not involve more than ten pounds additional weight.

their water supply. "I am surprised that I have never re-ceived any explanation of the course pursued in boarding my yacht without com-municating with me, although I charac-terized such action as discourteous at the time. In the absence of any such explana-tion I cannot but consider that the course pursued is not only discourteous, but is personally offensive and essentially de-structive of the amicable relations which lie at the foundation of the existence of international contests of this character." Mr. Howard Gould stated in an inter-view with a representative of the As-sociated Press that he would sail for home in a fortnight. "I will remain till then," Mr. Gould said, "In order to answer any question which my letter may prompt. 

CONSTANTINOPLE, Sept. 30 - The ports has issued a statement rejoleing at the apparent reaction in some of the London newspapers against the excessive anti-sul-tan agiation in Great Britain, which it declares is answerable for the terror in Constantinople, the foreign residents natur-ally fearing the wrath of the Museulmans




