HONORED BY NEIGHBORS

Citizens of Canton Have a Big McKinley Demonstration.

SAYS THE PEOPLE ARE AROUSED.

In His Address to His Own Townsmen the Republican Leader Expresses His Belief in the Triumph of His Party Principles Next Tuesday.

CANTON, O., Oct. 29.—Major McKinley's home fellow citizens, anticipated him last night when he approached the tariff question at the conclusion of one of his most remarkable addresses.

There was a tremor in Major McKinley's voice when, after repeated attempts, he responded to the home greetings of thousands of his neighbors and fellow citizens.

"It would be a hard heart, indeed, that would be unmoved by this magnificent demonstration of my neighbors and fellow townsmen who have assembled here tonight without regard to party, nationality or creed to give expression to their good will for the great cause for which I have been designated to stand.

"The people are aroused as never before, and I believe that the election next Tuesday will show a much larger vote than was ever polled in the history of our country before.

"They are not only going to vote, but they are going to vote right, as God gives them to see the right, independent of old party or political relations. It is not a question of candidates, it is not a contention for office, it is a contention for country; not a contention inspired by sectional consideration, but of devotion to the duty which affects and inspires the great heart of the American people.

"The American people are asked, as they enter the booths next Tuesday, solemnly to ratify a proposition that means national dishonor and repudiation. I do not believe they will ever do it. This issue may be obscured as it will by brilliant orators, but the plain, hard proposition cannot be hidden.

"The proposition is unworthy of American citizenship, and is an insult to the integrity, the good faith and the inspiring history of our great republic. It should receive, and I believe it will receive, fitting rebuke from the ballots of 15,000,000 of freemen.

"No nation can by the fiction of the law justify absolute itself from any honorable obligation. No nation can by the wrongful exercise of power contravene the eternal principles of truth and justice and not escape deserved and fearful retribution.

"But, my fellow citizens, the arguments have been made, so the case is ready to go to the jury, and the jury is waiting impatiently to announce its verdict, and, as Republicans, we confidently submit our contention to the great tribunal of the American people, the highest and greatest hope in the world.

"They will teach the world this year that they respect the law and order, and that they believe in public peace and tranquility, and not in disorder and chaos. They will teach the world that they will support the constituted authorities created and sustained by their own free will.

"I have always earnestly supported with whatever poor ability I possess that great economic policy by which not only Canton, but all other enterprising cities of the country, have been steadily advanced. Protection has always seemed to me to be the true, patriotic American policy, and I want to see it restored in the legislative and administrative branches of the government.

"I want to see it restored in the legislative and administrative branches of the government. Some of our political opponents have been denying that this question of the tariff is an issue in the present campaign. They will not even tell you how they propose to raise the money with which to run this government."
