Loaded with War Material for the President of Cuba.

## CONSUL SOLIS MAKES A PROTEST

On the Ground That the Vessel Has No Permit from the Spanish Cuban Authorities-The Consul Issues a Permit Under Protest.

JACREONVILLE, Fla., Jan. 1. - The tunner Commodore cleared at the cus-ty house at 5 o'clock yesterday afternoon 100 h a cargo of arms and ammunition signed to Salvador Cisneros, president consigned to Salvador Clisneros, president of the Cuban republic, at Clentinegos, Cuba. A crew of twenty-seven men was carried, despite the fact that the Commo-dore is of only 99 tons register. Most of these were Cubans. Among the number was Stephen Crane, the novelist, who signed as a seman at 200 per month. The cargo consists of 1,000 pounds of dyna-mite, 2 hoxes electrical apparatus, 300 rifles 201000 carried ses 300 marbets 14 rifles, 203,000 cartridges, 300 machates, 14 boxes of drugs and 3 bundles of clothing. Clearance papers were issued, notwith-standing that a formal protest was made
