FOUR LITTLE CHILDREN KILLED.

Several Others Severely Injured, Some of Whom May Die from Their Injuries. The Path of the Storm Narrow and Short, but Terrible.

SHREVEPORT, La., Jan. 4.—A cyclone leaving death and devastation behind it, struck the little town of Mooringsport Saturday. Four of the family of a Mr. Goodman were killed, and W. J. Morgan was slightly hurt by falling debris, but other members of the family did not fare so well. Two of his little children were badly crushed and cannot recover, while his mother-in-law received fatal injuries. The dead are: Willie, Maud, Hall and an infant. The Goodman home is a total wreck.

MORE STORM DISASTER.

At Benton, Ark., There Were Many Narrow Escapes From Death.

LITTLE ROCK, Ark., Jan. 4.—Communication was established with all of the towns south of here, on the Iron Mountain, yesterday, and the reports indicate that the storm, which was a cyclone, was in the town of Benton, where half a dozen small frame houses were demolished and several freight cars standing at the station were overturned. Several persons were more or less injured, and many houses were damaged.
