THIS WEEK IN CONGRESS. The Nicaragua Canal Bill May be Pushed Through.

Senator Perkins Will Endeavor to Get Up His Bill for the Creation of Such a Body. Nothing of Starting Importance in the House.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 18.—The friends of the Nicaragua canal bill expect it to be taken up early in the week, and that it will remain in place at the head of the calendar until disposed of.

Senator Perkins will make an effort, if opportunity offers, to get up the bill for non-partisan labor commission, and in this he likely will be antagonized by Senator Frye with the Hawaiian cable bill.

Senator Chandler today introduced the caucus committee's bill for an international monetary conference, and asked to have it voted on by the committee.

There are two appropriation bills ready to be acted upon, the agricultural and Indian, one for each of which may be introduced into some of the spare hours.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Jan. 18.—An Italian subject named Marco, who was second in command from Trebizond for exile at Erzeroum, and whose proprietary return to Constantinople for proper trial was demanded by the Italian ambassador, was a threat to send gunboats if the ports did not give him written promise of compliance, has been liberated.

General Turner's Vacation. NEW YORK, Jan. 18.—General William T. Turner, United States consul general at Rio Janeiro, was a passenger on the German steamer Capua, which arrived yesterday from that port. Mr. Turner has returned home for a brief vacation.

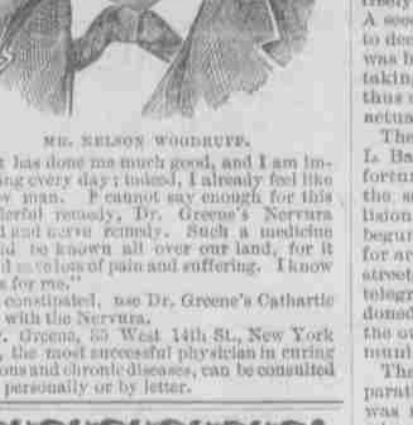
