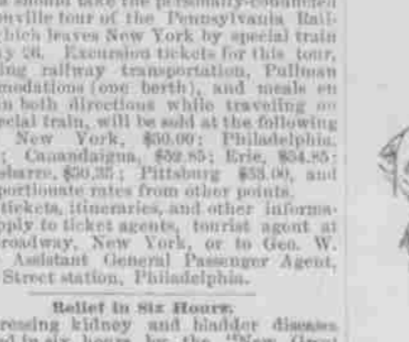

Two of the Men Had Killed Five of One Family.

Their Self Appointed Executioners Permitted the Two Negroes to Possess Each Other and Then Strung Them Up and Riddled Their Bodies with Bullets.

AMTIC CITY, La., Jan. 21.—Three negro murderers are dead. They are Arch Joiner and John Johnson, who at the last moment confessed their guilt of the killing of the Cotton family, and the Williams, alias Morrissey, who shot and killed the young wife.

Johnson's story of the slaughter of the Cotton family was peculiarly brutal. He said that he had always liked the family, and would not have harmed them had it not been for the fact that he was killed by the man who had done it.

Three hundred men approached the court house, the greater part on horseback, and immediately began searching the deputies, so that they could get the keys.

John was told that he would be taken, too, and immediately set up a wall that he was innocent, but the man who was taking him, however, knew him down and tied his hands behind his back.

While this was going on Johnson said to the man about him that if he hung Arch Joiner, whom he had implicated in previous statements, they would be killing an innocent man, as the man who helped him escape was not in the country.

John and Johnson walked about a man, when Johnson saw that he was no further, as he was exhausted. A wagon was procured and both negroes hustled into it.

When they arrived at the Cotton place Joiner set up a pious moan, and begged his captives to shoot him, as he preferred death by being shot to any other mode.

It was at first decided to shoot Joiner and burn Johnson at the stake, but the mode of death was afterwards changed to hanging for both of them.

After this statement by the negroes the men conveyed them several hundred yards from the Cotton residence and hung them side by side, and fired a volley of shots into their bodies.
