Line Inspection. The prime object in creating the office of mine inspector was to secure the greatest possible degree of safety for mine workers and protection for the property of the mine owner.

To make it possible to secure these desirable ends rational mine laws must be enacted, and the appointment to the office of mine inspector must be given to a conscientious and thoroughly competent man.

There was a time when many mine owners strenuously opposed the passage of laws for the protection of the health and lives of the miners. Their opposition was not due to a lack of sympathy for the miners, but they feared that inconsiderate laws would be enacted, and the result would be increased cost to the mine owner, and no appreciable benefit to the miner.

Practical experience with carefully prepared mine laws in Pennsylvania proved that the conditions under which the miner worked could be vastly improved, and at the same time a greater degree of safety could be secured for the property of the operator.

Other states followed Pennsylvania's example and enacted mine laws and provided for the inspection of the mines by state officials. The National Government did the same for the territories. Naturally Pennsylvania, with her great coal interests and greater mining experience, provided the most comprehensive laws.

Some of the other states have enacted laws that approach very closely those of Pennsylvania in thoroughness and efficiency, and followed Pennsylvania's example in providing for the appointment of mine inspectors by competitive examinations.

Many of the states, however, have placed the appointment of the mine inspectors in the hands of the Governor. The territorial mine inspectors are appointed by the President of the United States. When the appointment is made solely as a reward for partisan political services, the result is an incompetent mine inspector, and the inevitable results of incompetency follow.

It is possible for the Governor of a state or the President of the United States to appoint a competent man, but when they do so it is generally an accident. Sometimes a competent man secures the appointment by being backed by strong local influences, secured by his popularity and reputation as a miner. Such instances, however, are rare. As a rule, the appointee's fitness for the position lies in his ability to influence a few votes for the dominant party.

No greater outrage can be perpetrated on the mining interests of a state or territory than the appointment of a politician as mine inspector. It is bad enough to have politicians, ignorant of mining, enact unworkable laws, without having a politician to enforce them. A politician, ignorant of the science of mining, in the office of inspector is an injury to both the miners and operators. He is an injury to the miners because he does not know enough to bring about such conditions in the mines as will result in making them more healthy and safer. He is an injury to the operator because he does not know enough to bring about such conditions as will reduce the liability of accidents. An accident in a coal mine generally means injury or death to the miner, and financial loss to the operator. Therefore both operators and miners are interested in having competent mine inspectors and rational mine laws.

Rational mining laws can be secured if the more intelligent miners and the broad minded operators unite in recommending them. If the miners delegate their part of the work to demagogues, or the operators delegate theirs to narrow gauge men who cannot appreciate the value of the healthful and safe conditions in the mine, trouble will be experienced. No rational mine law was ever enacted in Pennsylvania till the operators and miners met together and suggested such measures as were fair to both sides. Rational mine laws will provide for a rational system of selecting the mine inspectors. There is only one way in which a man's capacity for the position can be judged, and that is by examination.

An inspector who wins his appointment by merit is "no man's man." He can fearlessly perform his duties, and can feel assured that he need not carry favor from any one to hold his position. Politics or religious belief should not be prime qualifications for such an officer.—Colliery Engineer.

FATAL FIGHT FOR LIBERTY.

Desperate Life Convict's Effort May Result in His Death. Boston, Aug. 11.—While attempting to escape from the state prison at Charlestown yesterday Herbert Willis, the young Taunton desperado who was recently sentenced to life imprisonment for the murder of Fred N. Strang, was fatally injured and his brother Edward, who assisted him in his break for liberty, was seriously wounded by the guards. Two of the latter were wounded by the Willis brothers. Edward Willis, who had gone into the prison to visit his brother, had contrived to pass a revolver to Herbert, retaining a weapon himself, and with these they tried to overcome the guards.

Herbert Willis, who is only 18 years of age, was sentenced to a life term of imprisonment last February for the murder of Frederick N. Strang several months previous. The murder of Strang was one of a series of high-way robberies and other acts of a similar nature which for a time terrorized southwestern Massachusetts and the adjoining districts of Rhode Island.

Strang was murdered, apparently, for his bicycle. Willis was arrested while at work in his father's butcher shop, after a violent struggle with the police. Subsequent investigation showed that Willis had formed a cave, in which he had hidden a large quantity of plunder, which was identified by persons who had suffered from his thievery.

Ex-Laborer Commits Suicide. New York, Aug. 11.—William W. Morris, 23 years old, who was released from Sing Sing prison on Aug. 1, had a quarrel with his wife, Margaret, 38 years old, at her home in Brooklyn yesterday, and fired two bullets into her breast. One of the bullets went through her right arm, shattering it, and making a wound in her breast, finally lodging in the wall. Mrs. Morris escaped to the basement. Morris then shot himself twice in the head, dying almost instantly. Morris was formerly an expert accountant for a New York jewelry firm, and was sent to prison for seven years for robbing his employers. On his release from prison he wanted to live with his wife again, but she refused. The woman will recover. Mrs. Morris is a daughter of Lord Conyers, of England, and was disinherited after her elopement with Morris.

The Hunt For "Cap" Hatfield. Williamson, W. Va., Aug. 11.—Wild stories are being circulated here by officers who are trying to capture "Cap" Hatfield, the desperado, who escaped last week from jail. The Hatfields are said to be strongly entrenched in a mountain pass, and to have recently killed Deputy Sheriff Johnson and four other deputies, but none of these reports are confirmed. The officers are in hot pursuit, but Judge Doolittle insists on the sheriff capturing Hatfield at any cost or risk. It is believed there have been encounters, but nothing definite can be learned.

Schlatter Wants to Marry. Canton, O., Aug. 11.—The man who says he is Schlatter, the healer, has taken out a license to marry Mrs. Margaret Ferris, widow of the man who invented the Ferris wheel. Mrs. Ferris says she has no thought of marrying him. She claims to be a Quaker and that Schlatter and Mrs. Ferris first met on Schlatter at Brady's Lake, a summer resort of the Spiritualists, about 25 miles north of this city. Mrs. Ferris became ill and Schlatter was called to treat her.

Serious Rainstorm in Washington. Washington, Aug. 11.—A severe wind and rain storm visited this city shortly after 8 o'clock last night, and did considerable damage. Torrents of water poured down, overflowing sewers, made streets running streams, and in the business center washed out a 14 inch wall of a big office building being constructed. Street car traffic was suspended, electric plants were materially affected and delays were experienced at the depots.

Senator Hainbrough to Wed. New York, Aug. 11.—H. C. Hainbrough, United States senator from North Dakota, yesterday announced that his marriage to Miss Chapman would take place in this city next Monday at 5 p. m. After the wedding the couple will go to the senator's home in North Dakota and remain until the session of congress begins.
