WARRIORS ASSEMBLING

A QUARTER MILLION VISITORS Will Visit the City During the Week. It is Said, Making the Largest Encampment Ever Held—The Veterans Will Behold a Living Shield.

Buffalo, N. Y., Aug. 23—Buffalo is all ready for the army of veterans who are on their way here to attend the 31st annual encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic. During the night hundreds of veterans and their friends arrived, and today they are coming in by thousands. It is estimated that nearly 250,000 strangers were in town on Saturday, and that from 15,000 to 20,000 came in yesterday. The various railroads entering Buffalo report that, in addition to the hundreds of regular trains, schedules have been prepared for 25 specials to arrive here by tomorrow noon. Among the prominent arrivals is J. C. Wynans, chief of command-in-chief Clarkston's staff; J. R. Lewis, past junior vice commander, and Daniel Ross, of Wilmington, Del., a candidate for junior vice commander-in-chief.

WARRIORS ASSEMBLING

Buffalo, N. Y., Aug. 23—Buffalo is all ready for the army of veterans who are on their way here to attend the 31st annual encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic. During the night hundreds of veterans and their friends arrived, and today they are coming in by thousands. It is estimated that nearly 250,000 strangers were in town on Saturday, and that from 15,000 to 20,000 came in yesterday. The various railroads entering Buffalo report that, in addition to the hundreds of regular trains, schedules have been prepared for 25 specials to arrive here by tomorrow noon.

Among the prominent arrivals is J. C. Wynans, chief of command-in-chief Clarkston's staff; J. R. Lewis, past junior vice commander, and Daniel Ross, of Wilmington, Del., a candidate for junior vice commander-in-chief.

The honor of flying the first pennant from any tent at Camp Jewett belongs to Reno Post, No. 64, of Williamsport, Pa. A detachment of 11 members arrived Saturday, and was assigned to tents 27, 28 and 29.

Colonel Wynans, of command-in-chief Clarkston's staff, estimates the number of visitors to Buffalo during the week at 250,000, making the largest encampment ever held. In speaking of the choice of the veterans for the next encampment, Colonel Wynans said that, so far as his information went, there was but one choice among the delegates, and that was Cincinnati.

Colonel Wynans says Pennsylvania will send the most people to the encampment, with New York second and Ohio third in attendance.

The decorations of the city with bunting and electric lights is elaborate. Nearly every building in the business section is more or less lavishly bedecked. On Main street opposite St. Paul's church, the business center of the city, stands the welcome arch. It is a massive structure in the form of a triumphal arch, composed of the letters "G. A. R." The arch, or span, is formed by the legs of the letter "A," which is in red and blue.

A block beyond the triumphal arch, at the entrance to Chippewa street, stands another arch, the gift of the colored people.

At the circle, at the junction of North street with Porter and Richmond avenues, are the reviewing stands, marked by the national colors. There are two of them, placed one on the north and one on the south sides of North street. Their total seating capacity is 5,000 persons. President McKinley and other distinguished guests will review the parade from one of the stands.

SENT TO AN ASYLUM. Edward Parker Deacon Suddenly Becomes Insane. OF A NOTED FAMILY IN BOSTON, He Gained Worldwide Notoriety Five Years Ago by Killing Marie Abelle in Mrs. Deacon's Room at Cannes, France—Little Hope of Recovery.

Boston, Aug. 23.—Edward Parker Deacon was on Saturday committed to the McLean hospital at Waverly, insane. He belongs to an old and once distinguished family of this city. On Feb. 17, 1892, he killed Marie Abelle in Mrs. Deacon's apartments at Cannes, France. Mr. Deacon came to Boston on Thursday last from Narragansett pier, accompanied by his trusted valet and nurse. They registered at the Hotel Bellevue, on Beacon street, which place Mr. Deacon has made his home for several years while in this city. He acted very peculiarly soon after registering, and seemed far from being in his right mind, but, being noted for eccentricities, nothing was thought at first of the manner in which he acted. On Thursday night, however, he grew violent, and his nurse and valet, who accompanied him, began to realize that Mr. Deacon was deranged. The attorney who has charge of Mr. Deacon's property, as trustee, was summoned, and responded at once. The attorney sent for Dr. Kelly, an expert on insanity. Shortly afterward Mr. Deacon became demonstrative and discharged his nurse. Another nurse was summoned, and all day Friday Mr. Deacon was almost uncontrollable.
