### EX-SENATOR McPHERSON DEAD.

Served in the National Senate From 1877 to 1893.  
Jersey City, Oct. 9.—John Roderick McPherson, one time Democratic leader in New Jersey, and United States senator from this state from 1877 until 1893, died late last night at Taylor's hotel. Mr. McPherson had been staying at the hotel for over a month. He had not been well for some time, being sick with intestinal trouble. On Tuesday last he was obliged to take to his bed. His condition was not alarming until toward the last.



EX-SENATOR McPHERSON, farming and stock raising. He became a resident of Jersey City in 1858. Here he entered largely into the live stock trade, and soon became one of the most prominent dealers. Mr. McPherson was a member of the board of aldermen of Jersey City from 1864 to 1870, and for more than three years of that time he was president of the board. He established in this city the People's Gaslight company and was elected its president. He was also president of several savings banks. In 1871 he was elected to the New Jersey senate by a unusually large majority, and served for three years. In 1873 he was a presidential elector, when the state went for Tilden by a large majority. In 1877 he was elected a United States senator to succeed F. P. Frelinghuysen, and served three terms.

### MRS. ATKINSON'S TRIAL.

Evidence That She Signed Judge Camden's Signature After His Death  
Chester, Va., Oct. 9.—In the Atkinson trial yesterday various letters written by Mrs. Atkinson to a Mr. Stankaker after the death of Judge Camden, her former husband, were read to the jury. In these letters Mrs. Atkinson asserted that Owens had not made for her hand. The letters showed subsequent to that of the receipt, William Worthington testified that Mrs. Atkinson, about two years ago, proposed to sell him land belonging to the Camden estate, and wrote and delivered to him the receipts for the purchase money, dating the receipts back to the time prior to Judge Camden's death. This witness received a severe cross examination. The defense endeavored to show that he was and in the employ of the prosecution for the purpose of giving and selling up evidence. Mrs. Atkinson asserted that Owens never shows, but the main evidence of the witness was not materially weakened. R. M. Peters, one of the best known farmers in the county, gave evidence for the state tending to establish alleged systematic forgery. He stated that Mrs. Atkinson, after the death of her former husband, wrote and delivered to him a writing which she signed with Judge Camden's signature in Peter's presence.

### A Profit For Importers.

New York, Oct. 9.—Unless the courts reverse the board of general appraisers' decision that goods were entered at the custom house on Saturday, July 24, before the signing of the tariff act, they will be able to collect from the government the extra duties—amounting to perhaps \$100,000,—they were compelled to pay as a result of the government's claim that the tariff was retroactive. The board yesterday sustained the protest of the importers against the position taken by the government.

### A MURDERER'S CONFESSION.

Declares He Has Killed Sixteen Persons, Including Fourteen Women.  
Rochester, Oct. 9.—A man named Gustave Muller has surrendered to the city police, confessing the murder of his wife and child. As proof of the truth of his confession he produced from his pocket four human ears. The police, on searching his house, found the two bodies. Muller subsequently confessed that he had also killed his parents and thirteen other persons. He claimed that he had killed 14 women, whom he had married in various parts of the world.
