TRIBESMEN REBUKED.

Another Victory for the British Under Sir Yeatman Biggs.

CHARGING UNDER DIFFICULTIES.

Brave Highlanders and Gurkhas Advance Through a Narrow Pathway in the Face of a Tremendous Fire, Suffering Severe Losses.

Simla, Oct. 21.—According to advices from Fort Lockhart the tribesmen having occupied Dargal Ridge, which commanded Chagra, on the Samana range, General Sir Yeatman Biggs sent the Second division yesterday to dislodge them. The position was very strong, and the tribesmen were prepared to fight only by a single path, along which the attacking force, consisting of the Gurkha regiment and the Dorsetshire regiment, was obliged to climb in Indian file, three batteries meanwhile shelling the Sangars.

The British companies crossed the zone of fire at a rush, sustaining heavy losses, while the remainder of the force reached the fighting line. A systematic assault was then organized, and 2,000 men with fixed bayonets stood waiting for the order to advance.

Three minutes before the word of command was given General Kempster telegraphed back instructions to the battery to charge where the Gurkhas lay. The rest of the force advanced, and under cover of this fire, the leading company of the Highlanders, amid perfect silence, rushed into the fire zone.

General Sir Yeatman Biggs will continue the advance, so as to hold the hills and then push on to Kharappa, where he will be joined by Sir William Lockhart.

SALISBURY'S REPLY

To the Proposals of the American Bimetalle Commission. INDIA MINTS TO REMAIN CLOSED.

The British Premier Declares That the Government is Unable to Open Them at Present—Germany Will Not Force a Tariff War.

London, Oct. 21.—Lord Salisbury last night sent to Ambassador Hay the reply of the British government to the proposals of the American bimetallic special commission, headed by Senator Wolcott. It is a diplomatically worded note, the leading message that the government of Great Britain is not able to reopen the India mints at present. He regrets the inability to accede to the proposals of the American commission, Great Britain having as great an interest as the United States and France in securing a stable par value for gold and silver and an enlarged use of silver.

In these circumstances, continues Lord Salisbury, the British government does not see the desirability of an international monetary conference, but will be pleased to consider any other practical suggestion from the United States.
