Terrible Cyclone in Benoit, Calcutta, Oct. 28.—A dispatch from Chattanooga capital of the division of the same name, in the Kurnool river, reports that a cyclone has raged in the Chittagong division and along the northern coast of the Bay of Bengal for eight hours, causing terrible havoc. Seven ships have gone ashore, all the houses in the district are more or less destroyed, several natives have been killed and large numbers rendered homeless.
Valuable Elevator Damaged by Fire. Buffalo, Oct. 28.—The Sturgis elevator situated on the island at the foot of Adams street, was totally destroyed by fire yesterday afternoon. There was in the elevator at the time of the fire 79,999 bushels of wheat, 20,000 bushels of corn and 100,000 bushels of oats. The grain was valued at \$106,000, and the loss on the building and machinery is \$100,000.

Howard Medlar Held For Making Threats Against His Father.
MAHANAY CITY, Oct. 28.—Howard Medlar, son of George L. Medlar, was taken to the county jail this morning in default of \$500 bail upon a charge preferred by his father. The young man has been living at Farley's farm, at East Mahanay Junction. Yesterday he came to town and got under the influence of liquor. At 8 o'clock last night he went to his father's house and demanded money. Failing to get it he threatened to beat his father and burn down the house. The young man is a disolute character. It will be recalled that about ten years ago he shot and killed Daniel Miller in a saloon in this town. He occupied with a sentence of a few years imprisonment and served it out. After that he wandered from one place to another and for a while was in the United States army. He is well educated and talented, but cannot be persuaded to put his talents to use in the proper channels. When but a mere boy he taught school in Rahm township.
The funeral of Adam Koch took place at nine o'clock this morning. Requiem mass was celebrated at St. Fidelis church and the St. Fidelis Beneficial Society attended the funeral in a body.

EDISON'S LATEST SUCCESS.

Roasting by Electricity the Iron Contained in Low Grade Ores.
Dover, N. J., Oct. 28.—Thomas A. Edison's success in recovering by electrical means the iron contained in low grade ores is demonstrated at the old Eden mines, a few miles from here. His plant is capable of producing 1,000 to 1,500 tons daily of almost chemical-pure iron. There are 200,000,000 tons of this low grade ore on the land immediately surrounding the plant, from which can be produced 50,000,000 tons of iron. The ore is blasted from the mountain sides, and then, by means of steam shovels and miniature railroad cars, conveyed to massive crushers, where it is broken up and passed on to other mills, where it is pulverized. The powder is then allowed to fall in close proximity to electro magnets, which deflects the iron to one side, and the non-metallic matter falls to the other side by gravity. The process is entirely automatic.
For eastern Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware: Pair; northeasterly winds; For Maryland: Pair in the interior, local showers on the coast; northeasterly winds.
