# PETER'S SAGACITY.

HOW A MULE SAVED THE LIVES OF A WHOLE FAMILY.

The Animal Detected Danger Which His Rider Failed to Discern—Must Have Known the Murderous Apaches Were in the House He Would Not Approach.

"It was an ordinary, everyday sort of mule, but he was knowing enough to save my life and the lives of Tim Masten and his wife and their two little children," said James Crossman, formerly a ranchman in New Mexico. Masten had the most stock of all of us, and he kept in his employ two herders for his sheep and cattle. I knew that he had gone with his family to Mimbro that day, and that being our postoffice, my purpose in riding over to his house was to see if he had brought me any mail. Just as I was starting from my house the thought of Chief Germonino, then on the warpath, came to my mind, and I went back and got my Winchester rifle.

"The country along the Mimbro river is hilly, with considerable timber in the valley and the vines leading down into it. For this reason I did not come in sight of Masten's house until I was within a hundred yards of it. I had got to where I could see the house, I myself being still in the timber, and we all were engaged both in farming and stock raising, with a market for our meat and vegetables at the mine camps in the Black range. Masten had the most stock of all of us, and he kept in his employ two herders for his sheep and cattle. I knew that he had gone with his family to Mimbro that day, and that being our postoffice, my purpose in riding over to his house was to see if he had brought me any mail. Just as I was starting from my house the thought of Chief Germonino, then on the warpath, came to my mind, and I went back and got my Winchester rifle.

# THE NEW NEW YORK.

Festivities That Will Mark the Birth of the New City.  
New York, Dec. 31.—When the birth of another year has been announced by the booming of cannon, the chiming of church bells, blowing of horns and tooting of whistles, the dawn of a grander, greater New York will be a fact. A celebration of the occasion has been arranged, which will begin tonight at 10 o'clock and will continue until the new city is an hour or more old. The front of the city hall has been draped with the American colors. In City Hall park electric lights—red, white and blue—have been hung. From the tops of the buildings about city hall searchlights will play upon the park. The larger buildings will be illuminated. Fireworks thrown from mortars in City Hall park will add to the spectacle.

A procession of floats sent by business houses, theaters and societies, escorted by independent military orders, civic associations and individual members will start from Union square at 9 o'clock. By midnight the pageant will have reached the city hall. The crashing of united societies of Brooklyn, New York in front of the city hall will be accompanied by the cannon.

At midnight Old Glory will be run up to the top of the city hall flagstaff, and while it is being run up 27 searchlights, each of 20,000 candle power, will be upon it. There it will wave, with hundreds of thousands cheer and sing "The Star Spangled Banner."
