



In the Trial of Sheriff Martin and His Deputies.

MR. SCARLETT'S CONTENTION.

As the Strikers Were Not Disorderly pleaded for more time than t the Sheriff Had No Right to Order the allowed motor the rate Them From the Public Highway.

Wilkesbarre, Pa., March 8.—The beginning of the end of the famous trial of Sheriff Martin and his deputies for the shooting of the strikers at Lattimer on Sept. 19 attracted the largest crowd to the Luzence county court house yeas terday that has yet been present. A big squad of pollcemen had to be called to force the people back. Attorney Scariett opened the argumment for the prosecution. He hold that the atrikers had a perfect right to shoot down and kill them. They had committed no act of violence, and consequently declined to dispersa when the sheriff read his proclamation. to them, notwithstanding that the which was not disposed of sheriff told them, "If you are determin-

ed to go to Lattimer you will have to go over my dead body." He deciated that the strikers had been wronged and murdered with vengeance and malle by the richer class who formed the deputies. As he closed he closed the trial as the greatest in the history of the world, armed men being charged with shooting down ruthlessly and

wantonly martyrs of labor on a public highway for merely making threats, and who had done nothing that could be classed as an act of violence. John T. Lenahan, chief counsel for

the defense, made a pathetic plea, and in an eloquent manner told how the prosecution's alleged crowd of 1,000 seaceable strikers were marching about the mining hamlets, feroclous and armed with deadly weapons, and who drove men from their labor. Mr. Lenahan reviewed the case very fully, appealed particularly to the jury's ove of law and order. This morning Mr. Palmer made the





Nebraska Freight Law Invalid. Washington, March 8 .- The suprem court yesterday rendered an opinion in the Nebraska maximum freight rate case. The opinion was handed down by Justice Harian. Justice Harian's opinion held the Nebraska law to be con-trary to the 14th amendment in that it authorized the taking of property without due process of law, and was therefore invalid. The opinion affirm-ed the opinion of the circuit court of appeals for the Eighth circuit, which was against the maximum freight rate law and favorable to the railroad.
