San Francisco, May 25.—The steamer China, which stopped at Honolulu on her way from the Orient, reports that the people of that city were making great preparations to receive the transports that will stop at Honolulu and which will stop at Honolulu by the next mail. New York, May 25.—Those who were shipped to Governors Island yesterday from the pier of the French line steamer two big balloons and equipments, which the government has purchased for use in army operations. The Spectator, continuing, says it is of the opinion that the government at Washington has decided to make a land attack on Havana while Admiral Cervera is in the bay. It is stated that the half drilled, half fed Spanish conscripts will prove fighting superiors to the hardy volunteers. Nevertheless, the Americans who expect a short war will be grievously disappointed.
