Cervera's Pathetle Report

Havana, July 8.—Captain General Blanco has resolved Admiral Cervera's report of the defeat at Santiago, in part as follows: "In compliance with your orders, I went out from Santiago de Cuba with all the squadron, and af-ter an unequal combat against forces more than triple mine, had all my equadron destroyed by fire. I accordingly informed the Americans and went ashore and gave myself up. The torpedo chasers foundered. Although not in such great numbers, the living are prisoners of the Americans. The conduct of the crew rose to a heighth that won the most entirestastic plaudits of the enemy."


