SPAIN'S PEACE PLANS. Premier Sagasta Says Negotiations Have Been Begun.

STATEMENT BY SENOR GOMAZA.

The Minister of Public Instruction In the Spanish Cabinet Says the Government's Polley Is to "Conclude an Houorable Peace."

Madrid, July 22 .- The minister of public instruction, Senor Gamazo, is authority for the statement that peace, honorable to the Spanish army, will shortly be concluded. In an interview in the Correspondenzia Militair, organ of the army, Senor Gomaza is quoted as suying:

"The suspension of constitutional liberty cannot be agreeable to the press, because it abrogates freedom and prevents the publication of news which costs much. But at this moment what can the government do but check the hostile campaigns waged against it? I was the first to beg the cabinet to treat the question as urgent, and I do not regret my action. I will say from my seat in parliament that I am convinced I did a real service to my country ...

"At the same time I can give you news which will please the press. The suspension of the constitution will not last long, for several reasons. One of them is the calminess displayed by the tours for the summer and early autumn of people and the army. 
