CRIMINAL COURT.

George Quinn, of Girardville, Called to Answer the Charge of Murder. Pottsville, Nov. 16.—The trial of criminal cases is not being disposed of as rapidly as is desired...

This morning the Quinn murder trial was called before Judge Lyons. On August 20th last, Patrick Scully, of Girardville, was struck on the head with a stone, sustaining a compound fracture of the skull...

During the greater part of yesterday afternoon there was on trial before Judge Bechtel, in court No. 1, an assault and battery case from Brandonville, in which Charles S. Leichert was the prosecutor and Harvey Jones and William Marsden the defendants...

Joe Zinkofsky, the man who lost his wife in a horrible manner some time ago at Colorado, and was convicted at court yesterday, was sentenced to three years imprisonment, instead of one, as erroneously reported in this correspondence yesterday.

James Marsden and Robert Danon were tried before Judge Lyons on the charge of assault and battery on oath of Adam Kline and Gordon Kline. They were found guilty and sentenced to pay \$100 fine, costs, and stand committed until sentence is complied with.

The Supreme Court, sitting at Pottsville, yesterday reversed the Schuykill county court—or rather, Judge G. F. Eadsby, of Berks county, who was specially sitting—in the case of Fricke et al., vs. Quinn et al. This is what has been known as the Port Carbon coal dirt case, which has been hanging in court for several years.

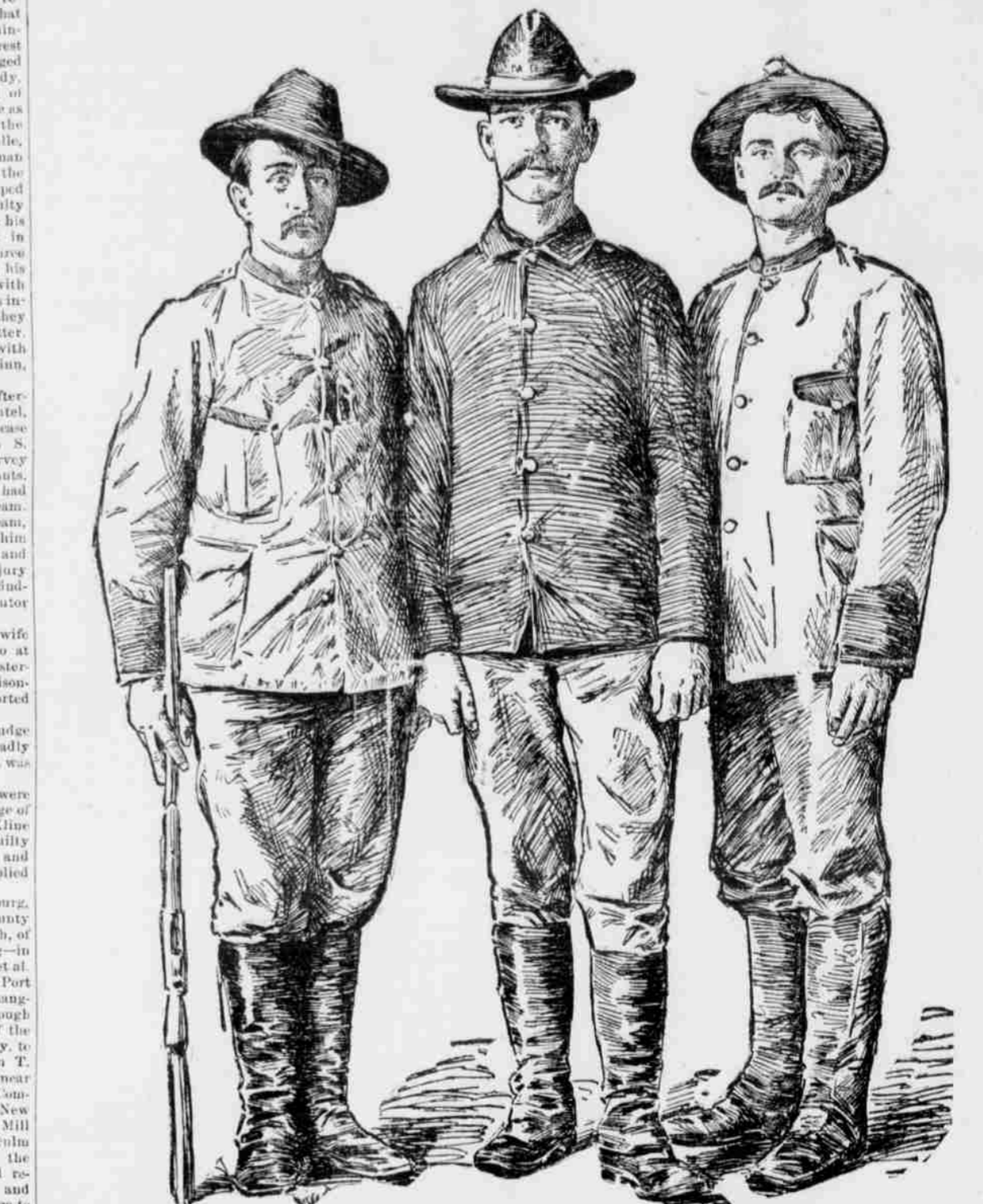
