Governor General Brooke Wants to Provide a Place For Him.

GARCIA'S FUNERAL DELAYED.

All Arrangements Had Reen Perfected When Word Came That the Gunboat Nashville Had Not Started From Norfolk With the Cuban Lender's Body. Havana, Peb. 2.-Governor General

Brooke wishes to provide a place in the Island administration for General Maximo Gomez II one can be found or created suited to his abilities and acceptable to his tastes. Thus far no definite suggestion has been made. The project is merely an idea, and its deelopment will depend upon the result of the governor general's interviews with Gomez. Some of the friends of the Cuban commander-in-chief think that he will be indisposed to take an appointment or pension from what he regards as a temporary military administration and is seeking to bring to a speedy termination. J. N. Casanova, a capitalist: Gullermo Dezaldo, a banker; Ricardo Sanchez and George Bryson have started a subscription to buy Gomez a house at El Vedado; where he may spend his declining years in peace after a stormy career.

Disputches received from Remedies say that most of the members of the staff of General Gomez have proceeded to Matanzas by special train, and that the general himself left yesterday morning for Camajuani and Placetas. His arrival here will be delayed by these stops along the route, but the will give him time to be present at the interment of Garcia's remains.

All day yesterday Havana was expecting the arrival of the United States gunbout Nushville with General Callate Garcia's body. Watchers were posted upon high buildings, and all eyes were turned toward Morro Castle for the signals that would notify the sighting of the gunboat and summon the waiting committee, the palibearers, the hearse, soldiery, patriotic clubs and city council to the wharf to receive the remains and escort them to the city half, where the session chamber had been sumptuously prepared for the lying in state. The council was unable to meet yesterday in consequence of of the expected functions.

Last night news was received from the United States that the Nashvills had not sailed for Havana, and the cablegram asked how the authorities from Senor Estrada Palma to Mayor abundened Perfects Lacoste, saying that the Nushville, with Geweral Garcia's body, had left Norfolk for Havana on Saturday

Lieutenant Colonel Smith, chief commissary of Cuba, thinks that the recent condemnation of canned meats by the meat survey board was improperly made, and as he regards the board's action as a reflection upon him he de-sires to have the whole matter made the subject of an inquiry by some higher authority. As the meat has been sunk in the gulf stream there is no chance for an expert examination.
