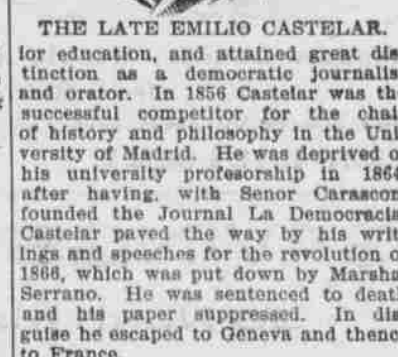
SEÑOR CASTELAR DEAD.

The Noted Spanish Republican a Victim of Albuminuria.

TO BE GIVEN A PUBLIC FUNERAL.

The President of the Short Lived Spanish Republic, and His Father Before Him, Had Been Compelled to Flee From Spain to Escape Execution.

Madrid, May 28.—Senior Don Emilio Castelar, the distinguished Republican orator and statesman, who has been suffering from an attack of pulmonary catarrh, contracted last winter, died yesterday at Murcia, capital of the ancient kingdom and modern province of that name.



Emilio Castelar was born in Cadiz Sept. 8, 1832. His father, an exchange broker, spent seven years in the English possessions, chiefly at Gibraltar, to escape sentence of death passed on him for his implication in liberal movements.

For education, and attained great distinction as a democratic journalist and orator. In 1856 Castelar was the successful competitor for the chair of history and philosophy in the University of Madrid.

During the troubles of 1868, when Isabella II. was dethroned, Castelar returned to Spain and labored for the adoption of a republican form of government, but the throne was re-established in 1870 with Amadeo as king.

When King Amadeo abdicated, in 1873, Castelar became minister of foreign affairs to the republic (Feb. 12) and president of Spain, with extraordinary powers (Sept. 7).

WOMEN PEACEMAKERS.

Their Resolutions Presented to the President of Peace Conference.

CONSIDERING LAWS OF WARFARE

Both Sections of the Committee Meet to Consider the Subject—Americans Insist on Discussing Matters Not Mentioned by Count Muraviev.

The Hague, May 26.—Mrs. Selonka, the famous peace advocate and promoter of the woman's peace crusade, yesterday presented to M. De Staal, president of the peace conference and head of the Russian delegation, an illustrated album containing the text of resolutions in favor of peace adopted by meetings representing several million women.

Both sections of the committee on the laws of warfare of the peace conference met separately yesterday and began the examination of the subject submitted to them.

It was proposed to submit the scheme to another committee for revision, and the question was then raised whether the conference was competent to deal with the matter.

The committee finally adjourned without reaching a decision. There is no truth in the statement that a proposal has been submitted to the conference to abrogate the provisions of the declaration of Paris, 1836, regarding the protection of private property in the time of war.

AMERICAN ARGUMENT WINS.

Will Discuss Matters Not Named in Count Muraviev's Circular.

London, May 26.—The correspondent of the Daily Telegraph at The Hague says: "Serious differences of opinion have been manifested between the United States representative and those of certain powers on the subject of discussing the seizure of private property at sea."

The Daily News says: "The British and American proposals, though simple, are more practicable than the scheme of M. De Maarten's of the Russian delegation, and it is likely that France and Russia, and even Germany, will ultimately agree with them."
