AN INDIGNANT JUDGE.

Chicago, Aug. 5.—After rebuking the administration of the John Worthington school for its lax supervision and characterizing its officials as "brutal, cruel and unfit for the positions they hold," Judge Haney, presiding in the juvenile court, yesterday held Redmond Lyons, a guard, to the grand jury in the sum of \$500 on a charge of assaulting Ray Stewart, a 12-year-old prisoner at the institution.
