### CONVICTION OF DREYFUS

#### So Says General Mercier, One of the Chief Prosecutors.

ONLY A MATTER OF TEN DAYS, It Will Be Received With Joy by the French People—Labor Will Not Appear at Court Martial Until Wednesday.

Rennes, Aug. 21.—General Mercier, who was minister of war when Captain Dreyfus was condemned, and who in the present trial is the virtual prosecutor, was called upon yesterday afternoon by a press correspondent with reference to the conviction of Dreyfus. Although unable to receive the correspondent in person, General Mercier sent his oldest son to convey the following explanation of his views:

"General Mercier considers it useless to attempt to convert foreign opinion regarding the Dreyfus question, in which, moreover, foreigners have no right to intervene. Foreign peoples have been misled by their press, which is violently Dreyfusian, for the very good reason that a majority of the foreign newspapers have been bribed by the Jewish syndicate. General Mercier considers the best reply to Dreyfusian statements abroad will be the condemnation of Dreyfus. This conviction is only a matter of ten days or a fortnight, for condemned Dreyfus certainly will not flee. Foreigners will see that their journals have deceived them, for they will recognize that the mass of the French nation, who will receive the news of the conviction of Dreyfus as joyful tidings, is not composed of fools, and that if the majority of the French applaud the condemnation, it will be because it is just and merited."

The correspondent then called upon Maitre Labori, who lives near General Mercier, the houses of both being guarded by gendarmes and detectives, who sit in chairs in the roadway in front of the houses. M. Labori was taking the air in the garden. The wound has not made any progress, the doctors hoped for, although there has been no relapse. In view of his general condition, his medical advisers opposed his going to court today, Tuesday or Wednesday, therefore, will probably see his reappearance in court this week. According to The Echo de Paris, as a consequence of Captain Cugnet's evidence, General Chamoin, who took the war office secret dossier to Rennes, has started suddenly for Paris. That paper in commenting upon the testimony offered by Captain Cugnet, the former attaché of the ministry of war, to whom was assigned the task of collecting and preparing the dossier of the Dreyfus, Piquart and Esterhazy affairs, says: "Captain Cugnet's evidence shows that the whole secret dossier has not been communicated to the court martial. A document has been withheld which proves the existence of a vast network of espionage under the direction of foreign military attaches and of negotiations on the subject of the Dreyfus case between several French notabilities and the representatives of foreign powers. The dossier withheld contains proofs that the sum of 25,000,000 francs was received in France from abroad for the purpose of prosecuting a pro-Dreyfus campaign."

### INSURGENTS DRIVEN OUT

#### Routed After Severe Fighting For an Hour and a Half.

#### AMERICAN LIEUTENANT KILLED

And Another Seriously Wounded and Three Soldiers Slightly Injured—The Filipinos Left Nineteen Dead in the Trenches.

Manila, Aug. 24.—One lieutenant of the Twelfth Infantry was killed and another seriously wounded while reconnoitering Saturday evening north of Angeles.

The Americans encountered a large force of insurgents and drove them from their positions.

Lieutenant Cole, of the Sixth Infantry, with 50 men, encountered 100 insurgents entrenched in the mountains of the island of the arrest. It rained in the afternoon and a half of severe fighting. The Americans had three men slightly hurt. Nineteen dead insurgents were counted in the trenches. Six rifles and a quantity of reserve ammunition were captured.

The insurgents recently cut the cable in Laguna bay, leading to Calamba, on the north shore of the lake, but the break has been repaired.

General Otis Reports the Fight.

Manila, Aug. 21.—First Lieutenant Alfred W. Drew, Twelfth Infantry, was instantly killed and First Lieutenant Willis Ulme, same regiment, severely wounded Saturday in an attack on insurgents in the vicinity of Angeles, by two companies of the Twelfth Infantry. There were no other casualties and the enemy was routed.

First Lieutenant Alfred W. Drew was born in Texas and graduated from the military academy in 1891, and was assigned as second lieutenant of the Twelfth United States Infantry. During the war with Spain he was major of the Third Texas volunteer Infantry.

### GENERAL JIMENEZ LEAVES HAVANA.

#### Says He Will Take Possession of the Presidency.

Havana, Aug. 21.—General Juan Isidro Jimenez, the aspirant to the presidency of Santo Domingo, left Cienfuegos yesterday on board the Polaris, bound for Manzanillo and Santiago de Cuba. He was arrested on Saturday by order of General Wilson and afterward released on General Brooke's orders. The arrest was made because it was supposed he was about to leave Cuba to engage in the revolution in Santo Domingo. After his release he remained at the Union hotel until he left the city. He complained bitterly to his friends of the arrest. It is rumored in Cienfuegos that a yacht will meet him at Manzanillo.

In an interview he said: "My mission is perfectly peaceful. I am unarmed and am going home to answer to my country's call to take peaceful possession of the presidency. I am more lawful to arrest me than it would be to arrest Mr. McKinley when, after his election, he was going from Canton to Washington."

"I am not a soldier taking expeditions with me. Nothing of that sort is possible. My appearance in the island will be the signal for peace and good government. An enthusiastic welcome will be accorded me by 90 per cent of the population of Santo Domingo, rich and poor, men, women and children desiring my arrival."

"I have absolute assurances that the acting president will cooperate as soon as he sees what the public desires. I cannot understand the action of the United States toward me. Many of my best friends are Americans and my policy when president will be to establish the closest relations between the two governments."
