MILK-CAN BRUSH.

Especially Designed to Reach Up Under Shoulder of Cans.

An invention of paramount importance to dairymen and farmers who sell much milk is the milk-can brush invented by a Minnesota man. This brush is designed particularly with the purpose of reaching up under the shoulder of the can and cleaning that portion which heretofore was only



rinsed out. As can be seen in the illustration, the brush is a wire framework with bristles on the outer edge. It is curved so that when it is lowered into the neck of the can the upper part fits naturally in the shoulder of the receptacle, which is otherwise almost impossible to thoroughly clean by hand. At any rate, the work of cleaning this portion of the can is ordinarily so difficult that only the most particular take the trouble to do it. With a brush made for the purpose it is likely that the percentage of cans that will now be free from the impurities that collect on the inside will be much greater than before.

Sunshine in the Dairy.

Sunshine is the dairyman's best friend. When the sun beats down hot in the summer we are apt to think it an enemy, but a week of clouds, even in July, casts a gloom over everything and makes both man and beast at cross purposes with the world. Sunshine is required to kill germs and microbes and keep both animal and human dispositions sweet. The Vermont cow barn that must be built so warm and tight lacks sunshine to keep the inmates in the best of health. All along our country's northern border, tuberculosis is on the increase in dairy herds.—Farmers' Mail and Breeze.

Warning to Dairymen.

We have repeatedly warned the dairymen that the oleomargarine law is likely to be amended next winter, and that the amendments proposed will destroy the value of the law, so far as concerns the protection of dairy products. Again, we ask you—have you written your congressman about it? Do you know his views? Does he know what you want him to do in the matter? Does he know what you are going to do to him in the campaign next year if he doesn't give you a square deal? This is no joke. It is a serious proposition, and no time is to be lost if the oleomargarine law is to be preserved in its present form.—Missouri Dairyman.

Milking Cows.

When cows are nervous or troublesome in any way at milking time they should be fed just before being milked. The giving down of the milk is governed by the nerves, and the more the cow's mind is taken from the milking process the less action the nerves will have on the milk secreting glands. Feed will make the cow more contented, which in turn will result in larger yields.

A Lack of Foresight.

The lack of high-class dairy cows, the high price of grain and mill products and the difficulty of securing competent farm labor have brought great hardship on the New England dairymen who have been neglecting the production of gardens, fruits, poultry, etc., which should find a place on every well-organized farm.

A Good Dairy Heifer.

When you see a calf that is everything that could be asked for in the way of gentleness, there is every prospect that she will make a good dairy cow. A wild calf can hardly ever be made fit for the dairy.

Late Corn Fodder.

The feeding of late corn fodder to dairy cows should be continued just as long as the corn is at all green. It is a splendid supplementary feed with the short autumn pasture grass.

Keep on Feeding.

Feed freely. Feed in summer. Feed in winter. Feed when heifers. Feed when cows. Feed when dry. Feed when giving milk. Feed! Feed! Feed!!!

A regularity of good feed and kind treatment will make it unnecessary to drive the cows in at night.

The milk must not be adulterated in any way.
