### FOXGLOVE GROWING.

ledicinal Plant Promises Fair Return on Cost and Labor of Production. Foxglove has for some years been ultivated as a commercial drug plant several European countries. It is a drly hardy perennial plant. It is of asy culture, growing best in rich well rained garden loams, but does not arive to advantage in wet soils or barn, sandy ones. Seeds and leaves both ontain medicinal virtue, but the latter, arefully dried in the shade to preserve e natural green color, form the only oduct that is now marketable. The arrent price ranges from 11 to 12 ents per pound, dry weight. The most eliable estimates of yield do not ex-sed 600 pounds dried leaves to the re, says Rural New Yorker.

Foxglove promises a fair return for e cost of growing, but any considerde acreage grown in this country ould quickly overstock the market. he present drug requirement that the aves be only picked from plants of vo years' growth at the commenceent of bloom greatly increases the st of production.

It is best to use the typical purple wered form of Digitalis purpures. hich may be had from most seeds

### FOXGLOVE.

The seeds are very small and ed but little covering. They may be out two pounds to the acre in rows ee feet apart to admit of horse cultiion or twenty inches apart if hand ture is intended. The ordinary garseed drill has been found effective. it is best to remove all covering achments, first setting the drill plow open a furrow not more than onef inch deep. Enough fine soll will rk in the furrow to cover the seeds the needed depth.

lants may also be raised in a seed like tobacco plants and transplantin June during dull weather to the d, setting them twelve or fifteen rt. Whether sown in field or nursthe seeds should be put in at the iest practicable moment in spring the soil can be got in good condias they are slow in germinating. is good practice to drop an occaal radish seed in the rows, as the er quickly come up and indicate rows so that cultivation and consent weed destruction may begin bethe tiny foxglove seedlings appear soil should be well enriched, red, worked and put in fine tilth cultivation and weed elimination thorough throughout the growseason. In field culture the plants uld be thinned to stand not over fifinches apart in the rows, as soon hey can be well distinguished.

t the approach of severe freezing ther a mulch of strawy manure or r free from seeds of troublesome ds will lessen the danger of winkilling. The plants bloom in June the second year, when the leaves uld be stripped and cured for mar-Foxglove should be grown as mial or two year crop. Individual its occasionally live several years so many die after blooming that it carcely possible to maintain a stand the second year.


