The Courier's New Plan.

Friday the DuBois Courier proposed a new plan for the citizens of Brookville, Punxsutawney, Reynoldsville, Ridgeville, DuBois, Clearfield and Philadelphia to secure good platform material and musical combinations for a Christmas concert.

The Courier proposes that the named towns work in conjunction and select such talent as can be had to make the concert, and advise the citizens of each town of the advantages. It is also proposed that a greater interest would be secured among the masses by the songs going out of the town and into the home of some of the townspeople. A list of songs is submitted.

People's Party Resolutions.

The People's Party of Reynoldsville, at a meeting held in January, 1893, gave expression to the following resolutions:

1st. We reiterate the preamble and endorse the Omaha platform adopted on the Fourth of July, 1892, also the state platform of the People's party.

2nd. We demand the repeal of the ordinance requiring hucksters, canvassers and agents to pay heavy license for the privilege of selling their products or wares as adding additional cost on the toilers for such productions and necessities of life.

3rd. We demand that gas lights be placed on street corners one at each crossing (on the main streets) and that guard rails be placed on bridge approaches and elevated sidewalks, also to make more safe railroad crossings for the convenience and safety of the public.

4th. We demand that the lot now occupied by the present condemned school building be used for a modern central school building large and convenient enough to accommodate the pupils many years to come.

5th. We demand the removal of the special officer known as night patrolman and the salary to be applied to public improvements and that money appropriated for improvement be equally distributed throughout the borough.
