AN ORDINANCE Granting to A. J. Invis. or his successors and assigns, the right to con-strier, maintain and operate an Electric Street Railway Line in the Borough of Rey-nold-ville, County of Jefferson and State of a cancel vania:

He if emerced and ordained by the Burgess and town council of the borough of Reynolds-ville, and it is hereby emerced and ordained by authority of the same:

Section I. That authority be and is hereby given to A. J. Payls, or his successors and assigns, to construct maintain and operate a double or single track street railway over, upon and along the following maned street in the borough of Reynoldsville, to wit, on Main street from the west end to the limits of the borough at the east end, provided the line be extended to Big Soldier and Sykosville and to Elemotra.

inpon and along the following named street. In the borough at the wast end to the limits of the borough at the east end provided the line be exteended to Hig Soldier and Sykosville and to Elecanora.

Section 2. That the said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns, shall have the right to enter upon, use and occupy a reasonable and necessary parties of said street as set forth in section one of this ordinate, for the purpose of laying and canstructing tracks, minitaling and operating an electric street railway thereon for the use and accommodation of the traveling public.

Section 2. That in constructing said railway the said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns, shall do no damage to public or private property and impele the use of streets as little as possible to public travel.

case of alteration of grade of the said street the said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns shall forthwith at his or their cost and expense make the tracks to conform to the new grade.

Section 7. The said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns shall fully indemnify the borough of Reynoldsville for all damages and costs which may be occasioned by carelessness of his or their employes in constructing, maintaining or operating said electric railway and in case of a suit against the borough said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns shall appear and defend the same when notified of such action or suit by the burgess of the borough. That if the said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns shall any time after the construction of said railway cease to operate the same and to run cars thereon, for a period of three months at any one time, except for unavoidable causes and necessary delays for repairs and alterations then the said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns shall remove said tracks and put the street in the same good coudition and repair for public use as before, should the borough council by ordinance so enact and upon detault thereof the borough authorities shall do the same at the expense of said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns. That this ordinance shall be holding on the above named street for a period of ninety-nine years.

Section 8. That the said A. J. Davis or his successors and assigns. Work in good faith shall commence and be completed one year from the date of this ordinance on said rallway in the borough of Reynoldsville and the rallway from the said eastern line of said borough to Rathmel, Big Soldier, Sykesville and Eleanora, shall be fully completed within two years from the date of this ordinance.

Section 11. In case the said railway is not completed within the time specified herein, then and in that case this ordinance and the franchise hereby granted, shall, at the option of the said borough, he considered forfeited and become null and void and of to effect.


