A Young Solomon.

A major and surgeon of the army stationed in the Philippines writes us that recently, when the chief nurse of a small base hospital in Southern Luzon was sent away there was a great struggle among the five nurses remaining for the vacant position, which meant a distinct increase in pay. Each one of the five came to the office of the surgeon in charge, to show cause why she should be appointed chief nurse, and why none of the others was entitled to that distinction. The young Solomon in charge was "up against it," but gave the following decision: "Each one of you must write on a piece of paper her exact age, and send it sealed to me. The oldest woman will be made chief nurse." There is still a vacancy as chief nurse in a small base hospital in Southern Luzon.—Argonaut.

Chicago's Merchant Prince.

Marshall Field, the Chicago merchant, was born in 1835 on a Massachusetts farm, and began business life in a Pittsfield dry goods store when 17, removing four years later to Chicago. He has given extensively to colleges and founded the Field Columbian Museum, in Chicago, with a gift of \$1,000,000.

Irrigating By Hand.

In irrigating his land the farmer uses many devices. Where running water is at hand he turns it to advantage by directing it over his fields in large channels. These are banked in with clay and subdivided into smaller and smaller streamlets, until every part of the ground has been reached. If no running water is found wells are dug and the water is drawn up by hand and poured into the main ditches, which are subdivided into numerous smaller ones. Hoies are dug in which rainwater accumulates, which is baled out when needed. The raising of this water in most cases, especially in the vicinity of Peking, is done very laboriously by hand.
