Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the State Highway Department in the Capitol Building, Harrisburg, Pa., until two o'clock in the afternoon of April 26th, 1910, when bids will be publicly opened and scheduled, for the construction of 4,100 feet of road, extending from Station 68-00 to Station 109-00, 14 feet wide, in Pinecreek township, in the County of Jefferson, under the Act of Assembly approved May 1st, 1905.
