

DEMOCRATIC CONGRESSIONAL CONFERENCE.

In accordance with previous notice the delegates of the 19th Congressional district assembled at the Court House in Ridgway, on Tuesday the 6th inst., to nominate a candidate for Congress.

The convention being called to order. On motion of Mr. Jenks, of Jefferson, James H. Eddy, of Warren, was elected President.

On motion of Mr. Brook, Julius Cooly of Forest, and Isaac Horton of Elk, were elected Vice-Presidents, and Geo. B. Goodlander of Clearfield, Secretary.

The Convention being organized, the counties of the district being called in Alphabetical order, the following named delegates answered to their names.

Cameron; J. B. Newton, John A. Eldred and W. W. Dickson.

Clearfield; Ezra Ale, Geo. B. Goodlander.

Erie; Monroe Hutchinson, Robert Leslie and H. L. White.

Elk; Geo. Weis, J. C. Chapin and Isaac Horton.

Forest; Julius Cooly, Archibald Black and J. S. Champion.

Jefferson; Wm. P. Jenks.

Warren; J. H. King, Jas. H. Eddy and E. A. Brook.

The next business in order, being the selection of candidates, Mr. White of Erie, moved that Hon. Wm. Bigler of Clearfield, be nominated by acclamation, the motion being seconded by the Warren delegation, the motion was unanimously agreed to.

On motion of Mr. Jenks, the Congressional Conference were required to meet at Ridgway on the *third Thursday* of August 1866.

The convention was ably addressed by W. P. Jenks, of Jefferson, Benj. Whitman of Erie, and Messrs. Hall & Chapin of Elk and Brook of Warren.

On motion, the Convention adjourned *sine die*, with three rousing cheers for McClellan, Pendleton, Bigler and the Soldier.

CONVENTION.

Pursuant to call the Representative Conferees of the district composed of Clearfield, Elk and Forest counties, Pa., met at the Court House in Ridgway, Elk county, on Thursday September 8, 1864, and organized by calling Chris. Kratzer Esq., of Clearfield to the chair and appointing Laurie J. Blakely of Elk, Secretary.

Present from Clearfield county—C. Kratzer, Frank Short and Alfred W. Valters Esq's; from Elk, J. McCauley, W. Hays and Laurie J. Blakely Esq's from Forest, J. D. Hunt, D. Eldridge and James Painter Esq's.

The object of the meeting having been stated; Mr. Painter of Forest, nominated Dr. T. J. Boyer, of Clearfield, and Mr. Hays, Dr. C. R. Earley, of Elk.

The Conferees having balloted, the result was announced as follows: of the votes cast on first ballot, Dr. Boyer received six, Dr. Earley, three. On motion of Mr. McCauley of Elk, the nomination of Dr. Boyer, was made unanimous.

Mr. Short of Clearfield moved the place of holding the next Conference, be Brookville, Jefferson county Pa. Mr. Painter of Forest moved, as an amendment, "Marion Forest county Pa." which was lost. The question recurring on the original motion; a vote being taken, the motion was carried.
