David Rowley, a well-known citizen and merchant of this place, died suddenly Tuesday afternoon at the home of William Pries, about three miles from Ebensburg, in Cambria township, of heart failure, induced by an attack of cholera morbus. Mr. and Mrs. Rowley drove to Ebensburg from their home yesterday, and while there Mr. Rowley was taken quite ill. He appeared to recover, however, and, not deeming his attack serious, started for home with his wife in the afternoon. On reaching the home of Mr. Pries, Mr. Rowley was so ill that he could not proceed, and he was taken into the house there and a physician summoned. The physician found the man in a very serious condition and repeated his visit with but slight hope of saving his life, and later the Rev. J. T. Tyson Jones was summoned to his bedside but found him in a dying condition. The end came at 2:15 o'clock. Dr. Rice, of Hastings, was sent for and also the children, but Dr. Rice arrived too late. H. J. Easley, of Hastings, was sent for and took charge of the body. Mr. Rowley had been in business in Hastings for quite a number of years. His death was a great surprise to everyone. The family has the sympathy of the entire town. Mr. Rowley was sixty-three years old and has been in Cambria county about ten years. He is survived by his wife and three children—Mrs. Thos. Prosser, of Barnesboro, and Joseph and Annie, at home.
