ORDINANCE NO. 99.

An ordinance levying an ass cording to the foot front rule on all owners adjacent to Beach property between Fifth and Sixth avenues, in the borough of Patton, to provide for the payment in part for the grading, paving and curbing of said street by the proporty owners, and providing for the payment in part by the borough of Patton, and providing that the Northern Cambria Street Railway company shall pay for the grading and paving of nine feet wide along their tracks between the points named, and providing the manner of making the col-

urer. Section 3. If said assessments against f this bank, for the election of property owners fronting on said the same shall be placed in the hands of the borough solicitor for collection, whose duty it shall be to collect the same, together with five per centum additional as attorney's commission, and interest from completion of grading, paving and curbing, by a municipal claim filed against the owner. Should the Northern Cambria Street

Railway company fail to make payment within 30 days from receipt of notice, then the claim or amount shall be turned over to the borough solicitor with instructions to bring suit in the court of common pleas to recover the amount, together with interest thereon from date of compeltion of paving on said street.


