FRIDAY TUBERCULOUS DAY

The Governor of Pennsylvania has designated Friday, Dec. 9 as Tuberculous Day. It is desired that all agencies reaching the public use this time to disseminate information as to the best methods being used to curb the spread of this dread disease, and the preventative measures being used. It is hoped that the different church through their ministers and workers, will devote a little time on this subject, as well as the teachers in the schools, and a special effort made to promote the sale of the Christmas Seals, funds from the sale of which are used to make war on tuberculosis and to care for those so afflicted by providing treatment.

A clinic is being held on Saturday, from 9 to 12 noon at the Spangler Hospital for the purpose of examining suspected cases of tuberculosis and admitting the suitable ones to the State Sanatorium and instructing and keeping the ones not suitable to send away for one reason or another under treatment and supervision.

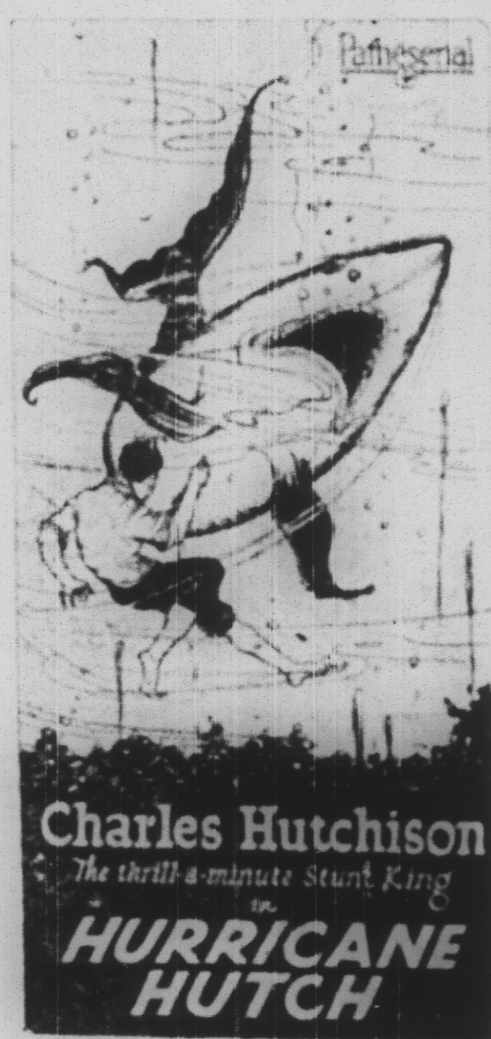
This clinic was changed to Saturday for the benefit of the school children so that it will not be necessary for the children to miss school. The children form a very important part of this clinic as the time of contracting the disease is in the young years of life and the child's resistance must be built up. This clinic is the center for all other agencies working in this line, it is a co-operative clinic, it not only cares for those attending the clinic, but through the different agencies it searches out all cases in the neighborhood and brings them under proper control.

TO HAVE FULL SERVICE OF PENN CENTRAL CO.

A crew of workmen began Tuesday to set the poles on the new power line extension which will serve about 10 farms between Patton and Eckenrode Mills. The holes have been dug and the poles are on the ground. The new line, with its service connections, will require about 48,000 feet of wire. Supplies for the building of the line are arriving every day and it is expected that all of the farms will be connected in the near future. The farmers who will benefit by this improvement are building this line at their own expense and will purchase the power jointly from the Penn Central Electric Co. E. H. Karheim, formerly employed by the Bell Telephone Co., the Huntington & Clearfield Telephone Co. and the Penn Central Co., is in charge of the construction work on the line.
