Years hence it is not improbable that folks will be telling of the time they were taken in the arms of the inventor of the telephone.

He has been laid to rest in a solid metal casket in a tomb hewn out of solid rock on Mount Pelee, Brough, Nova Scotia.

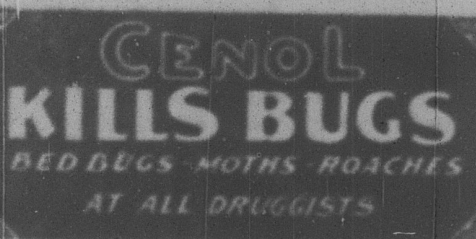

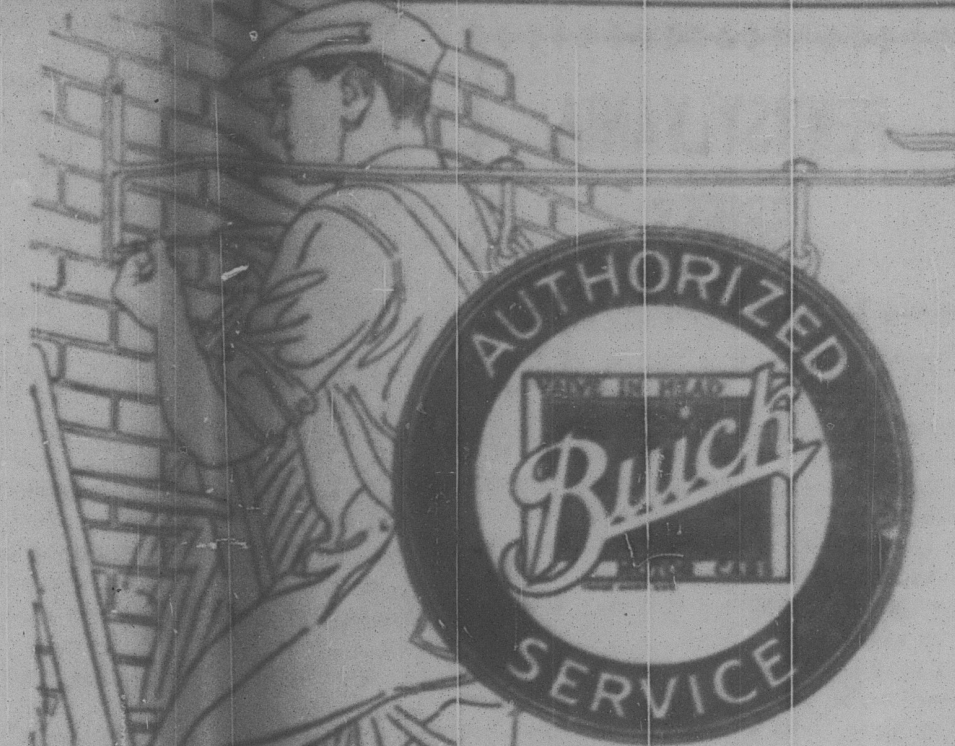

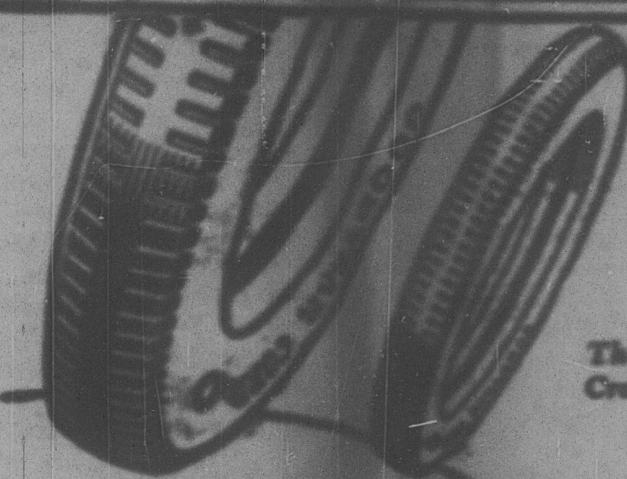
