

The KITCHEN CABINET

SEA FOOD

It is not necessary that one live near either coast to enjoy the delightful food that the ocean carries. For one may find many delicious dishes prepared from canned food. If you are fond of crabs, stuff some peppers with crab meat and bake them.

Fish Pie—Cook in three table-spoonsful of fat one sliced green pepper, one small onion, sliced fine, and three table-spoonsful of minced mushrooms. When all are well browned remove them from the fat and add three table-spoonsful of flour, one and one-half cups of chicken stock and one teaspoonful of salt. Stir constantly until the sauce thickens, then add one cupful of fish, salmon, scallops, crab meat, shrimp or lobster. If the scallops are small, cook in the chicken stock until they shrivel, add the other ingredients, put into small baking dishes lined with mashed potato, then cover each with mashed potato and brown in the oven. Serve from the dishes in which they are baked.

Scallop Chowder—Melt two table-spoonsful of salt pork fat in a saucepan; add one small onion, minced very fine; cook two minutes, then add two cups of raw sliced potatoes. Cover with three cups of water and, when the potatoes are tender, add two cups of milk and two cups of minced scallops; when they shrivel add salt and pepper to taste and six soda crackers. In serving, put a cracker in each soup plate.

Sea Food a la Poulette—Cook six oysters and six clams in their own juice until their edges curl. Melt two table-spoonsful of fat, add the same measure of flour; mix well and add one-half cupful of milk and one-half cupful of oyster and clam liquor. Stir the sauce until it thickens, then remove from the fire, and when well-cooled stir in the beaten yolk of an egg. Serve with toast points.

Stuffed Tomatoes—Fill tomato cups with chopped onion, and cucumber well seasoned with rich dressing.

FOOD FOR THE FAMILY
Cocoanut is a good food for most people whose digestion is in good working order, but for small children it should be given in moderation, if at all. A bit of cocoanut added to a salad, a dish of sliced oranges, a pudding sauce and a cake icing or filling adds much to both its appearance and flavor.

Cocoanut Orange Feringee—Take one-half cupful of bread crumbs, one-quarter of a cupful of milk, one-third of a cupful of orange juice, three table-spoonsful of sugar, one-half cupful of cocoanut, one table-spoonful of vanilla and one egg. Mix the bread, milk, sugar and orange juice with the bottom pulp. Beat the white until stiff and fold it in. Flavor with vanilla or with the ground rind of the orange; bake in small molds set in hot water. Serve with orange sauce. Cocoanut biscuits are very dainty for tea; add a half-cupful of cocoanut to a drop of bicarb. dough.

Cocoanut Potato Sandwich—Take three cupfuls of hot mashed potatoes, three egg yolks, six table-spoonsful of milk, one-quarter table-spoonful of pepper, two table-spoonsful of salt and the three egg whites, with one-half cupful of cottage cheese. Add the egg yolks, butter, to the potato; the other ingredients in order given, and finish with the cottage and egg whites folded in lightly. Bake until firm in a well-oiled baking dish set in hot water. Serve from the baking dish.

Cocoanut Macaroni—Take one cup of macaroni, one cup of milk, one cup of butter, one cup of sugar, one cup of cocoanut, one cup of raisins, one cup of currants, one cup of almonds, one cup of walnuts, one cup of pineapples, one cup of strawberries, one cup of raspberries, one cup of blueberries, one cup of cherries, one cup of peaches, one cup of apples, one cup of pears, one cup of plums, one cup of figs, one cup of dates, one cup of figs, one cup of dates, one cup of figs, one cup of dates.

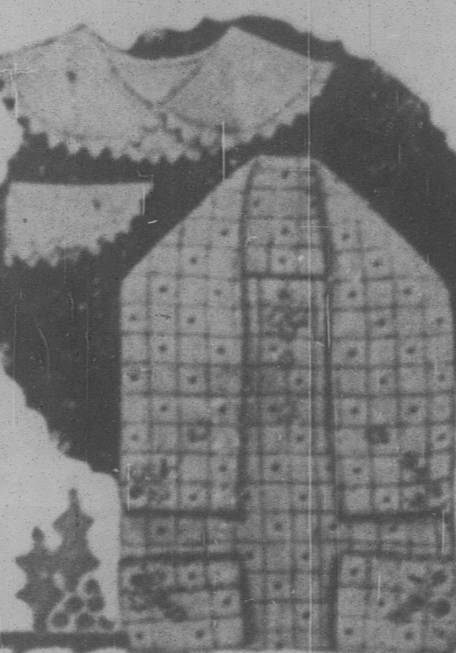
Pretty Home-Made Gifts

Pretty Neckwear Sets



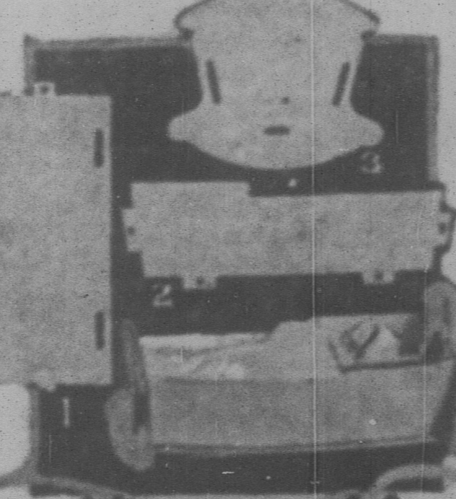

Cardboard Doll Cradle



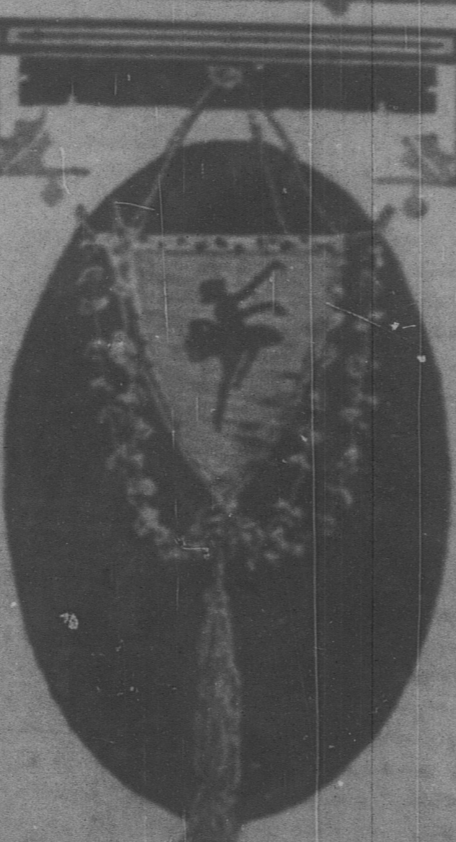
Little girls get much joy out of dolls' furniture. A Dutch cradle and the pieces that make it are shown here, in heavy cardboard. The ribs on the side pieces (Fig. 2) are perforated and slip through slots in the bottom piece (Fig. 1) and through the head and foot boards (Fig. 3). Little wood pegs, thrust through the perforations, hold the pieces together. Fig. 1 is 9 1/2 inches long and 4 inches wide. Fig. 2 is 9 1/2 inches wide at top, 8 1/2 inches at bottom, 2 1/2 inches wide at head, 2 1/2 inches at foot. Fig. 3 is 2 1/2 inches high and 5 1/2 inches wide. The rocker measures 6 1/2 inches across. The cradle may be finished with painted decorations.

Some one you know is hoping to find a new pair of garters or a rich ribbon bag in her Christmas stocking and here are garters and bags that are guaranteed to please. 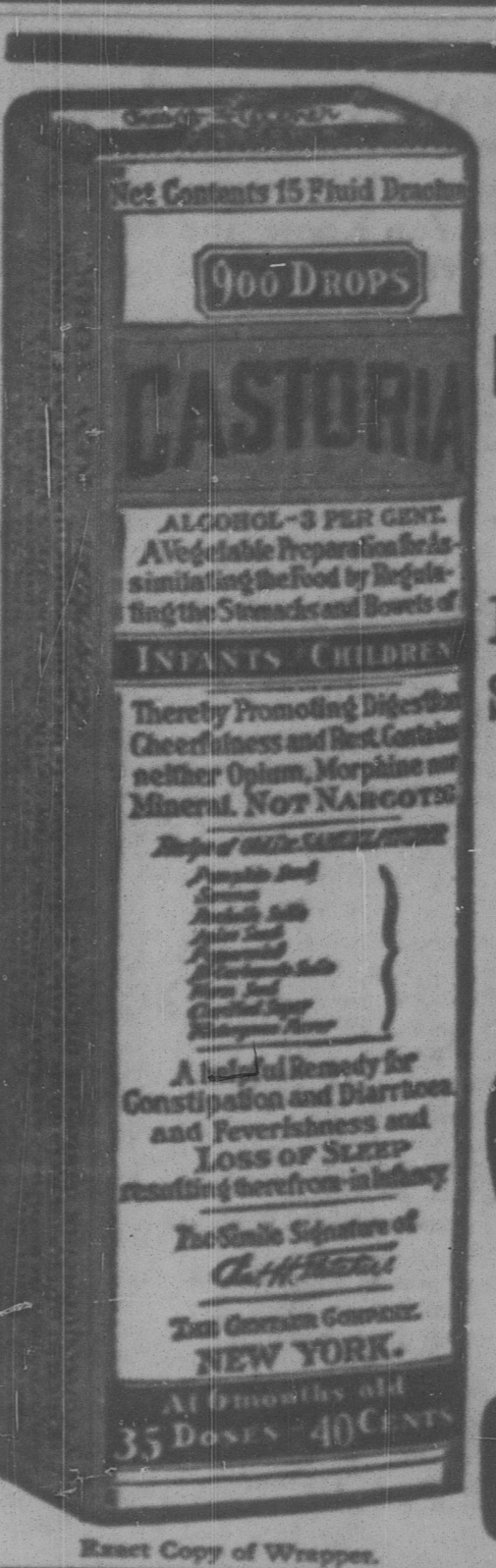
