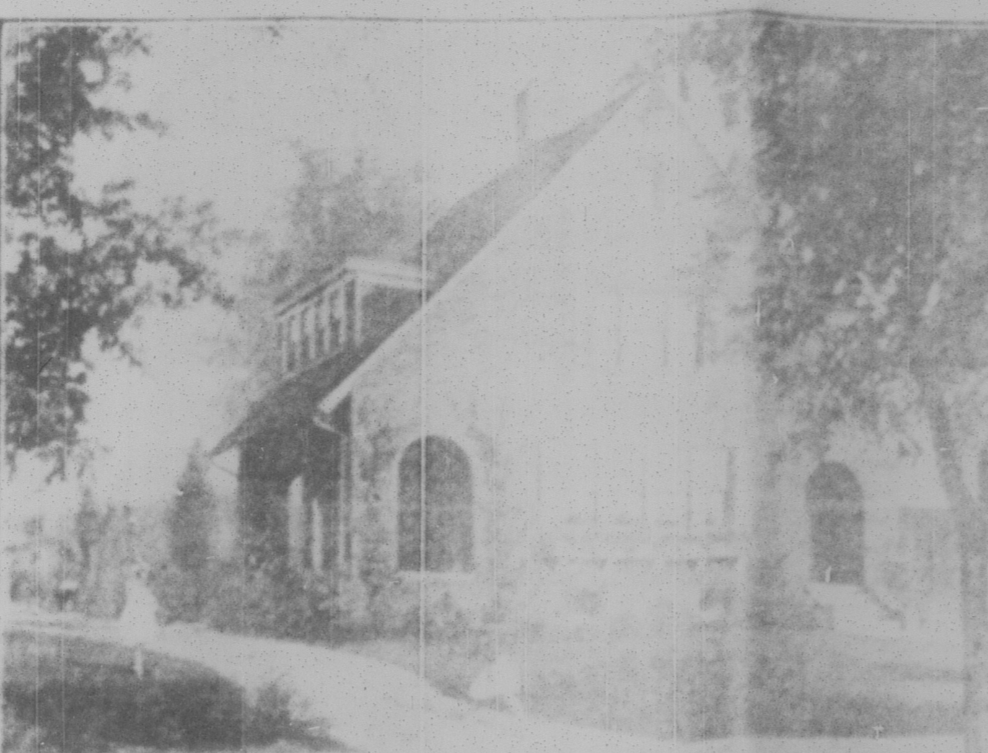
THE LITTLE BROTHERS OF THE NATION

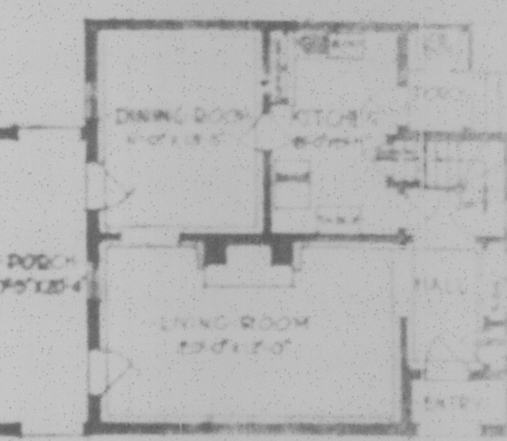

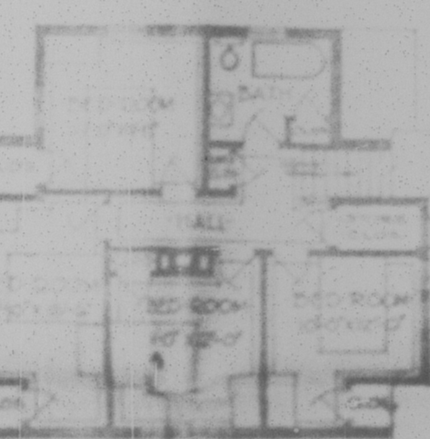

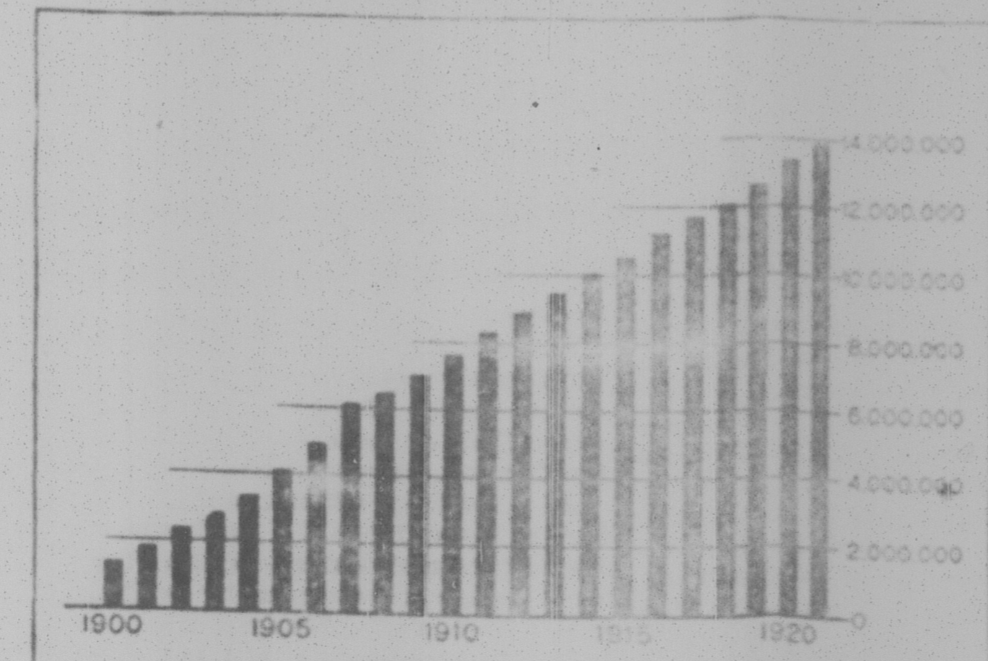

STEADY GROWTH IN NUMBER OF TELEPHONES IN UNITED STATES



The growth of the telephone business in the United States is shown in the above diagram by bars representing the total number of telephones, for each year from 1900 to date. It is a matter of common knowledge that the United States leads the world in point of the extent of telephone service; but the great degree of American superiority is not so generally appreciated. According to a recent survey, on January 1, 1921, there were 28,850,000 telephones in the world, and of these 13,323,370, or 61 per cent, were in the United States. In other words, with only about one-sixteenth of the world's population, the United States has almost two-thirds of the world's telephones. The number of telephones in all the countries of Europe combined was 5,280,000, or only 25 per cent of the world's total. In the relation between telephones and population, Europe is today exactly where the United States was some 23 years ago. Of the total number of telephones in the world on January 1, 1921, about 14,950,000 were operated by private companies, and about 5,900,000 by various governments. In the United States, where tele-
