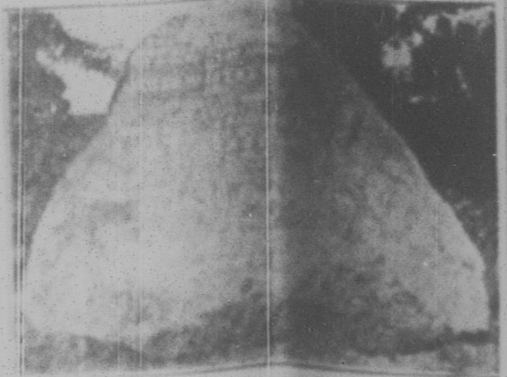

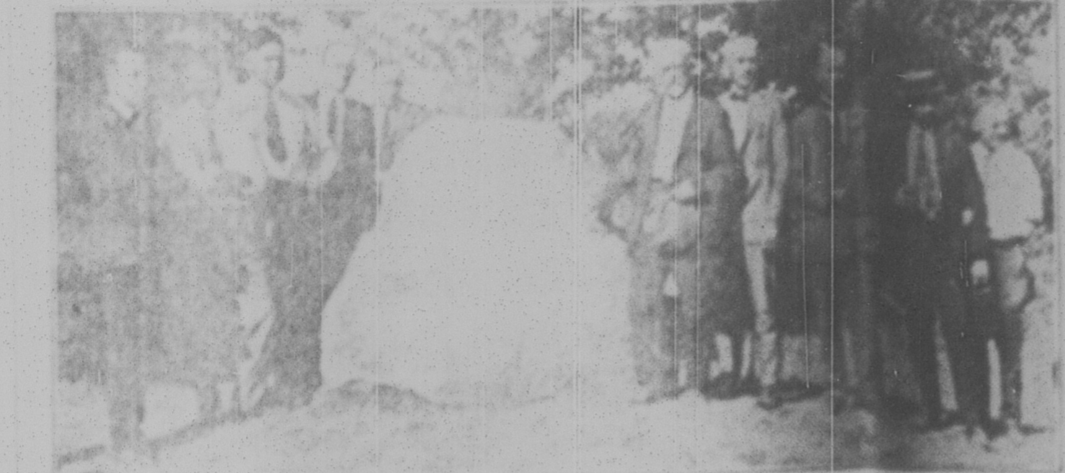
MONUMENT FOR FAMOUS TREE
