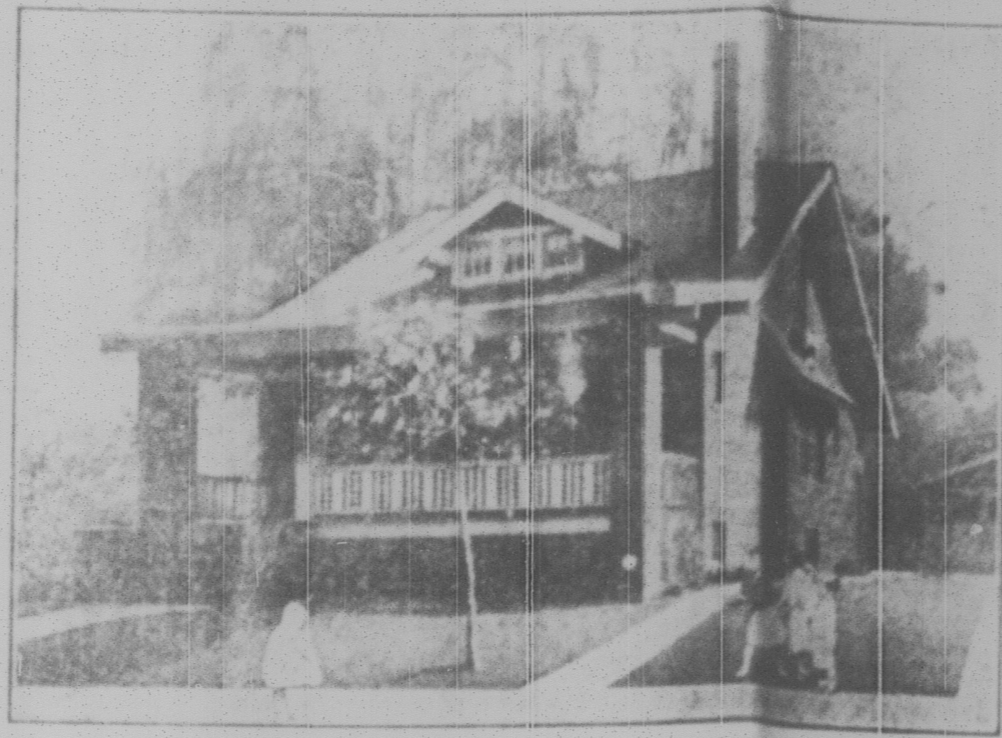

A Well Arranged Bungalow



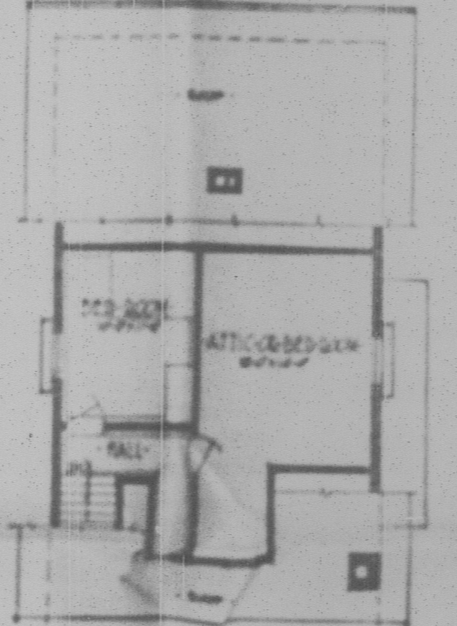
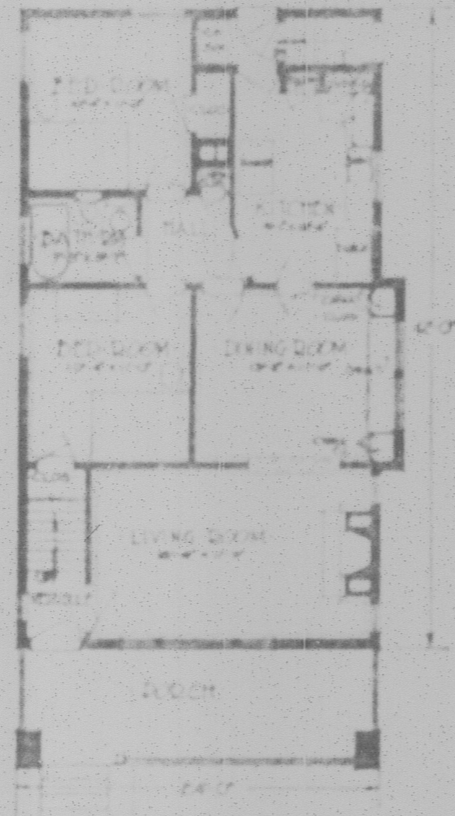
The Owanka, Design A708

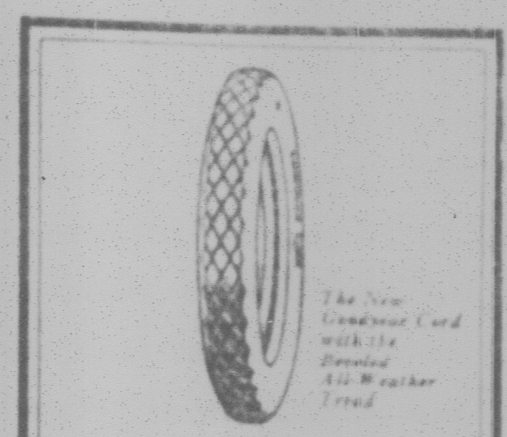
