

CROP ACREAGE IS

Data Compiled in Conjunction With Government --- Com-* parisons for 2 Years

MANY ACREAGES REPORTED

Interesting News Items, Briefly Condensed, Picked Up At the Depart. ments Which Are Of Interest To the People Of the State.

Harrisburg, Pa .- According to figures issued from the State Depart. ment of Agriculture today the acreage of Pennsylvania crops for 1924 is showing a decrease as compared with 1923. The data has been compiled in conjunction with the United States Covernment.

The winter wheat acreage is placed: at 1.203,000, or 94 per cent. of 1923 while the acreage of spring wheat is gives as 10,000, or 94 per cent, of 1923. Other acreages are reported as foi-

All wheat, 1.213,600, or 94 per cent. of last year; corn, 1,479,000 or 96 per cent. of 1923; oats, 1,018,000 or 87 per cent. of 1925; barley, 11,300 or 93 per cent. of 1923; buckwheat 250, 000, or 110 per cent, of 1923; rye, 202,000, or 94 per cent, of 1923; white potatoes, 244,500 or 98 per cent. of 1923; sweet potatoes, 1,900 or 95 per cent. of 1923; tobacco, 44,000 or 98 per cent. of 1923, and hay, 949,000 or 101 per cent, of 1923

The acre yield for the various crops is estimated as follows: Winter wheat, 16.5 bushels; spring wheat, 16.6 bushels; all wheat 16.5 bushels; corn, 34.8 bushels; oats, 36.7 bushels; burley, 24.9 bushels; rye, 16 bushels; buckwheat 20 bushels; white potatoes, 102.1 bushels; sweet potatoes. 131 bushels; tobacco, 1,296 pounds; hay, 1.53 tons.
