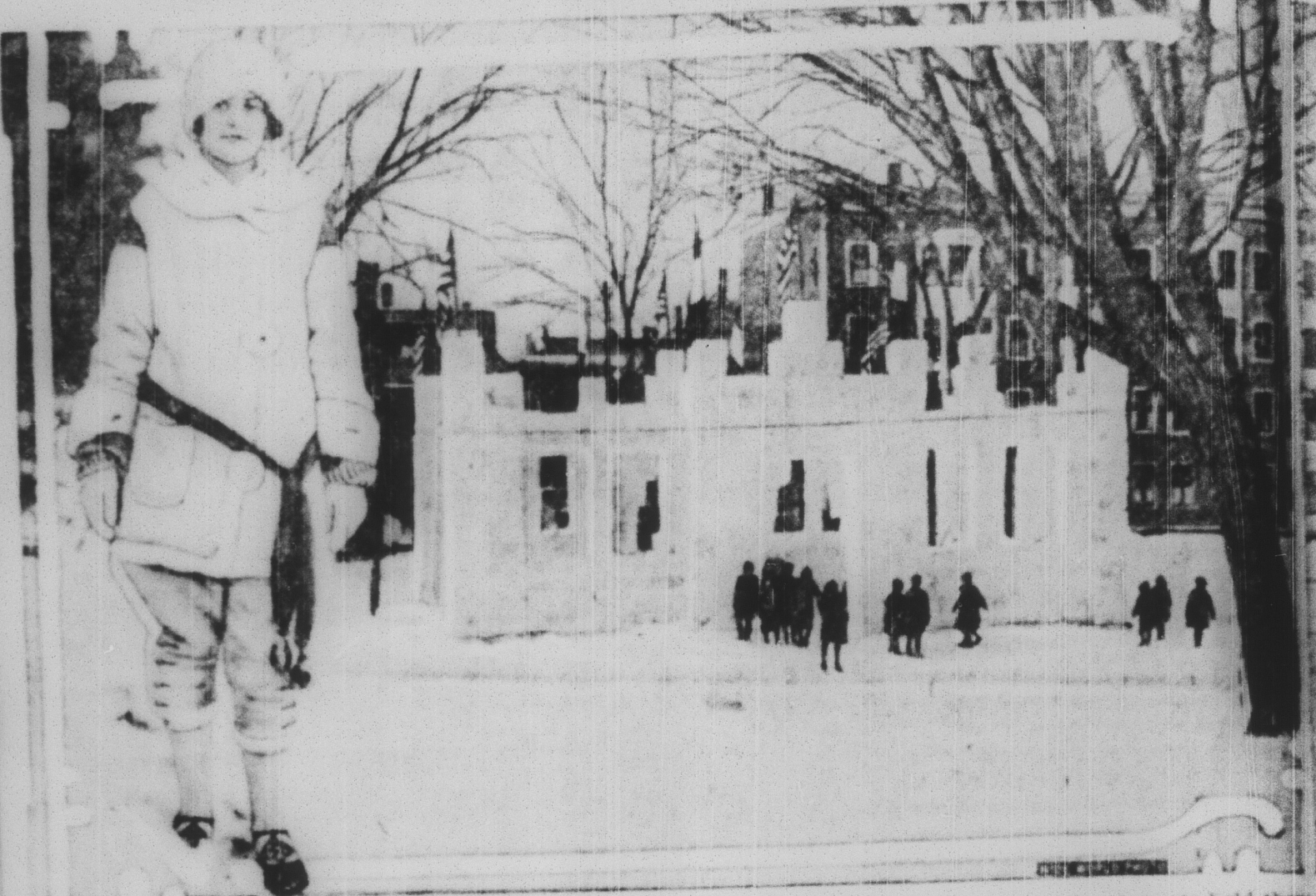


Maine's Ice Palace and Winter Carnival Queen

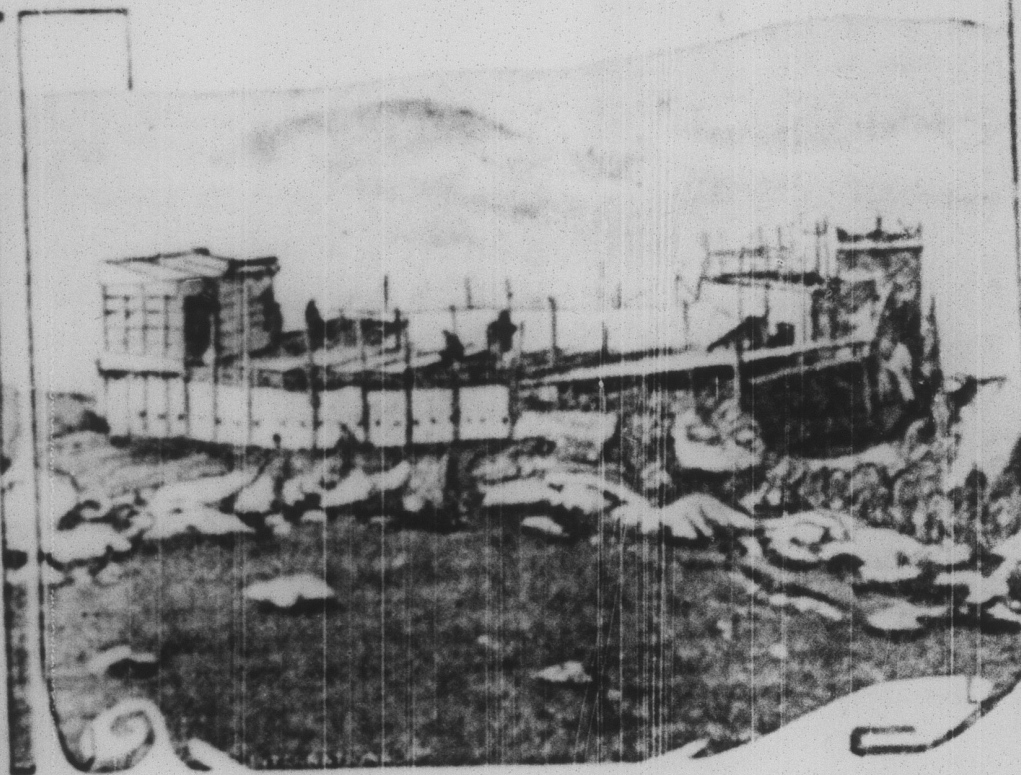

Radio Shorthand Medal Winners



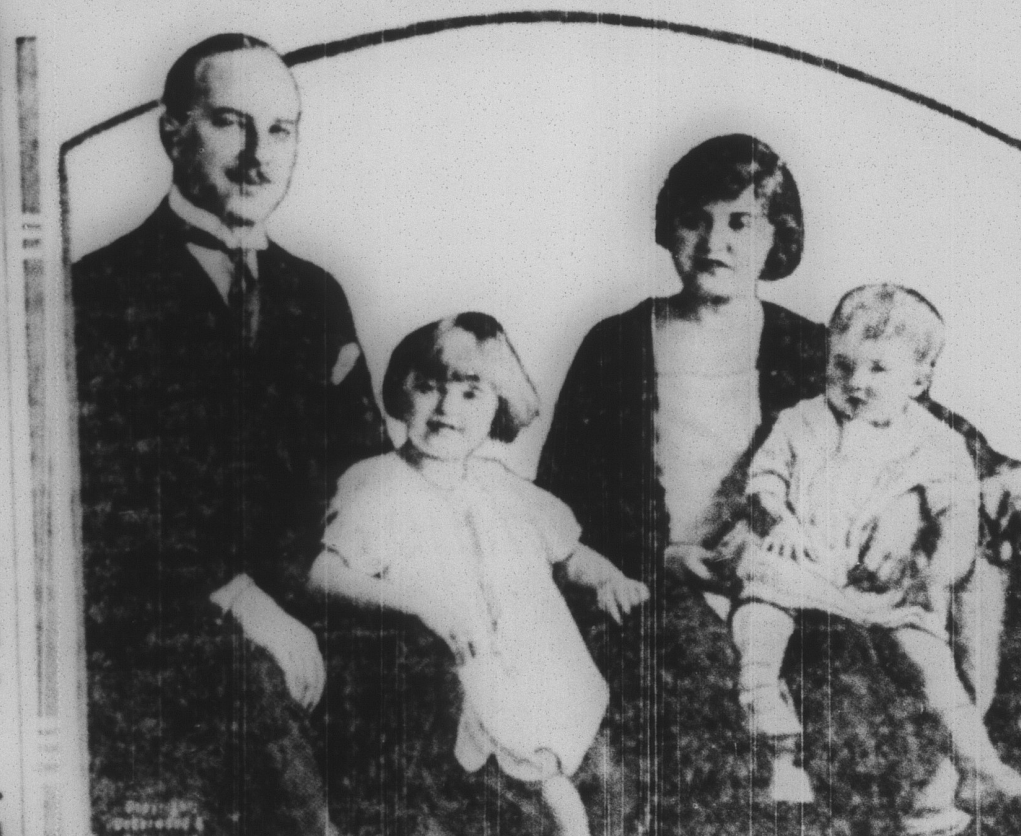

"I didn't just feel in the poetry mood today. You know some days I feel in it so much more than others."

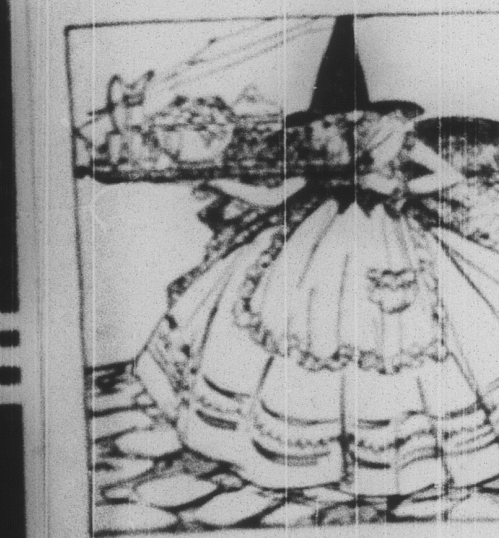
They didn't have to make any excuses at all.
