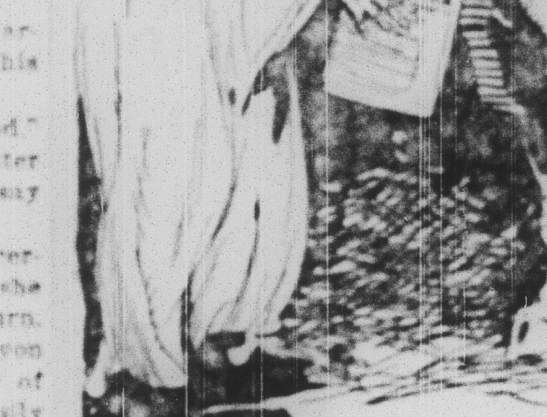
STRANGE "GHOST" PLAYS PRANKS ON BADGER FAMILY
