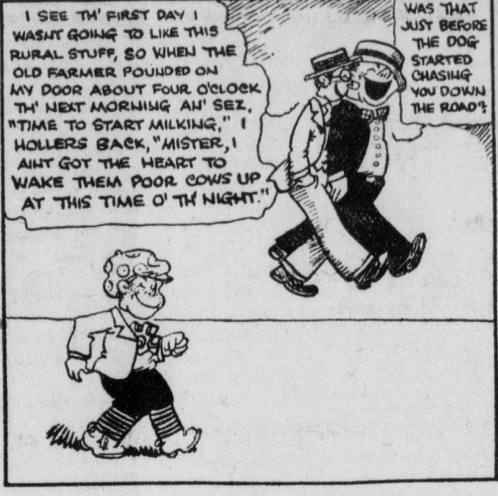
I JUST LOVE TO LISTEN TO PASSERS BY

WATCH DOG

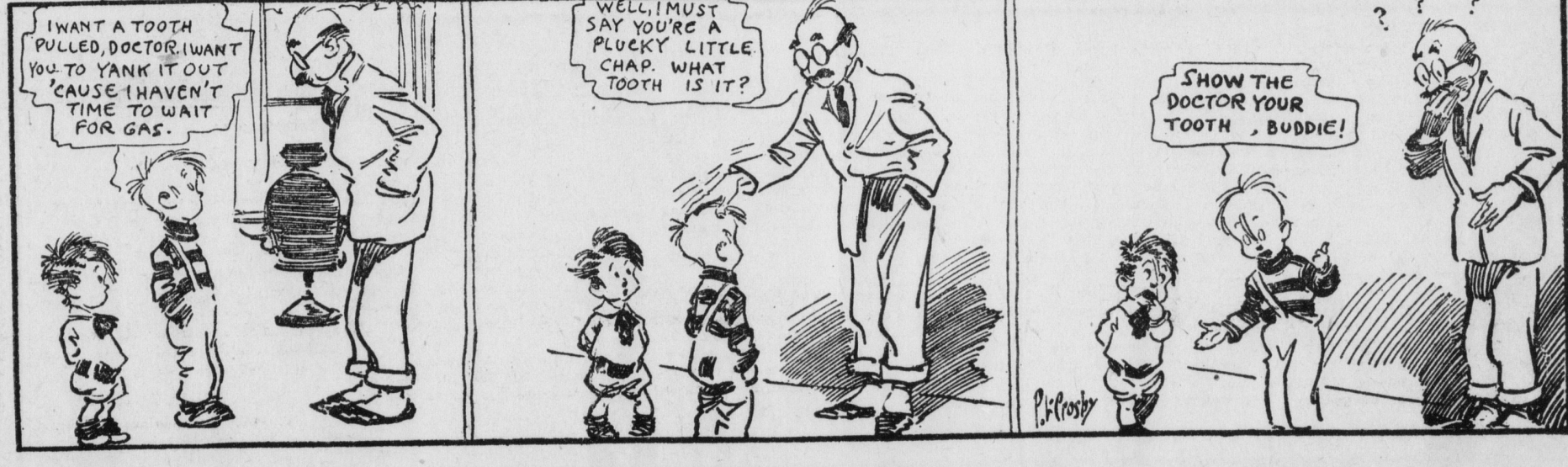


"Why do you call that pup a watch dog?" "Well, he keeps time with his tail and he's full of ticks."
