PATROL ACTIVE IN THE RECOVERY OF AUTOS

Tabulation of stolen cars has been a function of the Bureau of Motor Vehicles of the Department of Highwoys of he state of Pennsylvania for five years luring which time thousands of cars have been reported stolen and):e-covered. Not all those reported stolen have been recoverred, and it is this feature that has caused considerable trouble for the Bureau.

Duringovember of this year 3305 circular letterrs were mailed to owners of cars stolen, requesting cars etolen and information ag to possible re-coveries not reported. In such cases the owener does not receive a license application for renewal and may be delayed in getting tags. Meanwhile he will be fortunate if highway patrol-men or state police do not stop him on the highway patrolthe highway and accuse him of stealing his own car.

When Highway Patrolanen or State Police recover a stolen car a special report is mailed to the bureau which clears its records. Each week a report is mailed to police, insurance companies and detective agencies listing the cars stolen and those recovered. These bulletins also go to each state in the Union many of which keep similar records, All in all the auto thief has a hard time keeping his stolen vehicle for any length of time, and most of them abandon them in a day or so.




