At the basis of each of these estrangements is nothing less than sin, selfishness. At the basis of universe estrangement is economic sin,-selfishness. We obey lower impulses only to find ourselves at war with the higher within us,. We have hurt things and people and ourselves and a fundamental estrangement has taken hold of us. How can this estrangement be tak-

I have just said that God was hurt in any hurt that is given to anything or person .Then does God wear a perpet-ual cross? He does. But we should never have seen the cross unless it had been lifted up in time, for we are bounded by our senses, and need a sense-view of that hidden cross. The Time cross was lifted up and we have seen That cross says one thing as a Man who hung there stretches wide His arms as if to embrace everything and every man: "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do." There is forgiveness, release, power.

"Oh, Father Latimer," said one, "I prithee, hear me, when I read in the New Testament, Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, it is as if the day suddenly broke." Yes, when we allow Him to invade us with His redeeming grace, it is as if the day suddenly broke - a day with no night at the end.

This is the real unity—the unity of the soul with the Divine-with nothing between! Hugh Fawcett says: " I became conscious of a subtile change stealing over me. It was as if I were a cup which was slowly being filled with living water. I was invaded by some will in which was infinite love, peace, wisdom and power. I felt never before known humility and gladness, an inexpressible certainty that within all the discords of life there was Divine intention and a final harmony, that the darkness in me was in this timeless moment resolved in light and the error redeemed in ultimate comprehension.

The unity with God brings unity within one's own self. The discords, the inner clashes are at an end, and one is at pease with itself.

The Kingdom of God brings unity at the center of one's being with the center of the universe and hence lays the foundation of all unities.
