**JUDGE MICHAEL MUSMANNO**  
Democratic Nominee for the Superior Court of Pennsylvania  
Judge Musmanno is a distinguished Constitutional lawyer, being the author of "Proposed Amendments to the Constitution," a book accepted by the U. S. **EDUCATION REVISION STILL NEEDED IN STATE**

Physical Education, Cooking, and Nutrition Needed Subjects Says Health Expert

School and college health and physical education programs, while widespread and valuable, "still leave much to be desired," John E. Kelly, national director of civilian health training, asserted at Harrisburg recently.

"False economy, community indifference and short-sighted planning have hindered the growth of a completely rational and sufficient health program," the Philadelphia told the Pennsylvania Education Congress.

"More time in each school day should be allotted to physical education. Too many schools and communities lack adequate gymnasium and athletic fields. Too little attention is given to the value of summer camps, particularly for the undernourished and the physically retarded. Too many girls receive little or no instruction in the fundamentals of nutrition, the care of clothes and the more practical aspects of cooking."

"Both our citizens and our state and national leaders must be impressed in this crisis with the full importance of the place that physical health and health education should occupy in the training of youth, so that any future problem of physical fitness will be minimized."

Kelly said it was the objective of his office to lead aid to programs throughout the country "which are contributing to the building of national morale with emphasis of physical fitness."

Dr. William Mather Lewis, the state selective service director, asserted in another address that "military service is of distinct advantage to the soldier."

"The discipline, the regular outdoor life, the balanced rations send him back to civilian life a better man than when he went," Dr. Lewis told the educators.

"Furthermore, although it is primarily and mainly the duty of the Army to give the training that will make men efficient soldiers, vocational training is not lacking. At the reception station the recruit is put through a comprehensive test of 150 questions. After this test he is interviewed by experts, who tabulate his former vocational and educational experience. Later he may take a refresher course in any one of scores of subjects. He will be given work where his skills will be developed and his technique improved."
