This payment will be in addition to any other allowance which may be computed for the farm. The 1942 program continues the \$20 minmum payment which may be earned on any farm. The \$20 minimum payment does not include the tree plant-

ing allowance. While there are only minor changes n the soil-building allowance rates, officials pointed out that final provisions of the 1942 program when drafted will increase the emphasis on conservation and soil-building work en individual farms.
