Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Anna (Havriska) Sabella, and four children—John, above mentioned; Mary, Philadelphia; Michael in the Army in Texas, and Helen, Philadelphia. Funeral services were conducted on Wednesday morning in the Colver Orthodox Church by the Rev. Father Leochumak, and interment was made in Lloyd's cemetery at Ebensburg.

Father Paschal Laurie, T. O. R.
Rev. Father Paschal Laurie, T. O. R., procurator at St. Francis College, Loretto, and an instructor at the college for many years, died at 7:45 o'clock on Thursday night in Mercy Hospital, Johnstown. He was 63.

Death of the veteran Franciscan father terminated an extended illness. Father Paschal became ill early in October and was admitted to the hospital Oct. 26, in a serious condition.

Born in Harrisburg, he was a son of George and Theresa (Slange) Laurie. He was educated in the schools of Harrisburg and became associated with St. Francis College in the early 90's. He was a brother at the school and a teacher until 1910 when the Third Order Regular was organized. At that time he was ordained into the priesthood and was assigned to missionary work.

Father Paschal did missionary work for the order for a number of years and worked in fields throughout the East and Middle West. He served for several years at churches in South Dakota.

When he returned to St. Francis a number of years ago he was assigned to the position of English instructor and was named procurator of the college.

A pontifical high mass was celebrated Saturday morning in St. Michael's church, Loretto.
