KILLING OF SONG BIRDS ILLEGAL; HEAVY PENALTY

In an announcement during the past week Game officials warned parents to see to it that youngsters do not shoot at song birds in the neighbors' gardens or nearby woodland with their BB guns and other air rifles.

They further stressed the fact that the use of an air rifle to kill any kind of wild birds or animals in Pennsylvania is unlawful.

These birds are protected by state law and the Federal government also has stringent regulations protecting song and insectivorous birds. Killing or wounding robins, bluebirds, catbirds, woodpeckers, and other protected species is a federal offense involving a maximum sentence of \$500 in fines, six months in jail, or both; the State law provides for a \$10 penalty.
