The State Game Commission has announced a special six-day season for deer season in Schuylkill, Susquehanna, Wayne and Wyoming and parts of Carbon and Luzerne Counties.

This special season will be from Dec. 9 to 14, inclusive, and was ordered to relieve farmers, truckers and deer hunters from the season.

The Game Commission also formally fixes these other hunting dates and bag limits for 1946:

- 1. General small game season from Nov. 1 through Nov. 30, to open at 9 a. m. (EST) with daily bag limits of four rabbits, six gray, black or fox squirrels, two male ringneck pheasants and four quail.
