Both Patton and Gallitzin hold outstanding records for the season. Patton has a record of 17 victories against 2 defeats, winning their last 14 games. The two setbacks came early in the season to Ebensburg, 34-22, and to Lilly, 26-24. Patton defeated both of these teams in their second encounter, dropping Lilly 35-25, and Ebensburg, 41-30.

Gallitzin has somewhat of a similar record, with 13 victories against 2 defeats, both setbacks coming at the hands of a strong Conemaugh High squad early in the season by scores of 36-27 and 48-38. Incidentally, Conemaugh has won the West Central League and sports a record of 22 wins against a lone setback by Johnstown High by the score of 41-37.

Last year Lilly defeated Patton, 33-24, for the North Cambria League Championship. Lilly then went on ahead in the Class B playoffs, defeating Richland Twp. South Cambria winner, by a score of 39-33, but dropped to Bellwood, Class B Dist. 6 winner, by the score of 32-24. Bellwood then lost to Boswell, Dist. 5 winner, by a 34-29 margin.
