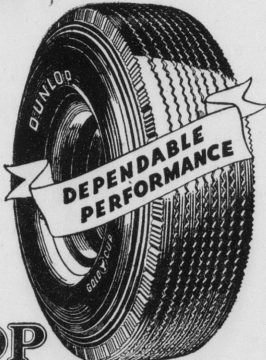

Barnesboro Sisters Have Dual Weddings

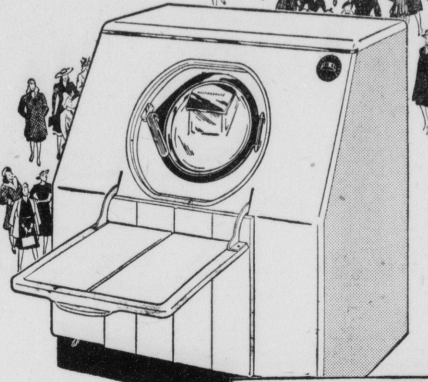

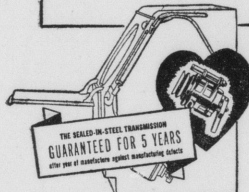
